Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Year –Rafael
Colón

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board recognize Rafael Colón as this year's Fort Wayne Community Schools Teacher of the Year and a top 10 finalist for Indiana Teacher of the Year.

RELATED INFORMATION: Rafael Colón, a second-grade teacher at Northcrest Elementary School, has worked in FWCS since 1997. During his seven years at Northcrest, he has worked diligently to make the learning experience fun and engaging for his students. He is a member of several committees at Northcrest and is the recipient of the Unsung Hero Award from the Allen County Local Education Fund and ITT Industries, and a recent FWCS staff spotlight honoree.

Award

RELATED INFORMATION: Indian Village has been selected to receive the prestigious Blue Ribbon award by the *No Child Left Behind* Blue Ribbon Schools Program. The designation honors outstanding public and private K-12 schools from across the nation that are meeting the national No Child Left Behind mission to ensure every child learns, and no child is left behind. Blue Ribbon recipients are the national models of excellence that others can learn from, according to The Secretary of Education Rod Paige.

Indian Village is one of only nine schools in Indiana to receive this recognition, and one of just 36 urban schools across the country. According to information from the U.S. Department of Education, urban or large central city schools make up only 14 percent of the schools making the grade as Blue Ribbon recipients.

Area Administrator Dr. Lillian Lowery presented an overview of what we are doing to enhance achievement for all our students. And Indian Village Principal Stephany Bourne and staff members presented a report on the progress this outstanding school has made.

Ratification of FWEA Contract	<p>Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Ratification of FWEA Contract:</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board ratify revisions to the Master Contract agreed to between the Board of School Trustees of Fort Wayne Community Schools (FWCS) and the Fort Wayne Education Association (FWEA).</p> <p>RELATED INFORMATION: The FWCS and FWEA Bargaining Teams have reached tentative agreement on a one-year Master Contract for teachers. The 2003-2004 contract is retroactive to August 15, 2003 and expires August 14, 2004. Details were attached.</p> <p>A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Geoff Paddock, that the recommendation concerning the Ratification of FWEA Contract be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.</p>
Health Insurance	<p>Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Health Insurance:</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board award the contract for the self-funded health insurance program to Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield effective October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2004.</p> <p>RELATED INFORMATION: Earlier this year, a Request for Proposal was distributed resulting in competitive bids from eight (8) carriers. Following a review of these proposals and presentations from three of the carriers, Anthem, CIGNA and ISTA Insurance Trust, it was determined that the package provided by Anthem, including both administrative fees and contracted provider discounts, will provide our employees with the best all around package.</p> <p>Administrative fees will increase for the 2003/2004 plan year by 5.5%; however, the provider discounts provided by Anthem were significantly greater than those provided by the other carriers. Changes in benefits are described in the FWEA contract.</p> <p>A motion was made by Carl A. Johnson, seconded by Robert A. Armstrong, that the recommendation concerning the Health Insurance be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.</p>
Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants	<p>Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants:</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants funded by the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$4,975.</p> <p>RELATED INFORMATION: The goal of the Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants project is to support the distribution of free paperbacks to children to promote reading. These competitive mini-grants are designed to provide books to students, foster reading at home, and motivate students to develop a love of reading.</p> <p>Grant applications are being submitted by the following elementary schools:</p> <p>Abbett (\$1425) Arlington (\$675) Brentwood (\$1,750) Pleasant Center (\$1125)</p>

Requested funds will be used for the implementation of programs that (1) encourage parents to support their children's literacy development, (2) stimulate students' reading, (3) promote school-community partnerships, (4) encourage family literacy activities, and (5) provide personal books for individual students.

The mini-grants address advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education; and Strategy VI, Meaningful Relationships with Families. Coordination of the grants rests with individual principals and Sandy Sunderland-Willis.

A motion was made by Kurt A. Walborn, seconded by Robert A. Armstrong, that the recommendation concerning the Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Title IV Safe
and Drug
Free Grant

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Title IV Safe and Drug Free Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the administration's application for and acceptance of a Title IV Safe and Drug Free Grant for the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$178,968.

RELATED INFORMATION: Title IV funding is provided to schools under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). The allocation is based on enrollments for both public and non-public schools in the FWCS attendance area.

Title IV is an entitlement grant provided to supplement the general fund. Monies from Title IV will be used to
