Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

FWCS                    **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize Northwood Middle School  
Teacher of                    Teacher Todd Roberts for being named the district's Teacher of the Year and state runner-up.

Todd Roberts                **RELATED INFORMATION:** Although he comes from a family of educators, Todd Roberts believed  
he wanted to be a lawyer. Now Roberts knows – just three years after coming into the profession – he  
was always meant to teach. Earlier this month, Fort Wayne Community Schools' 2007 Teacher of the  
Year was named Indiana Teacher of the Year Runner-Up.

"Mr. Roberts understands the importance of innovative education," State Superintendent of Public Instruction Dr. Suellen Reed said. "We can all learn from his creativity and dedication to each and every student."

Mr. Roberts has taught TV Broadcasting, Communication Technology, Advanced Television and Contemporary Media to six- through eighth-graders at Northwood Middle School since 2003. He was selected as FWCS Teacher of the Year earlier this summer.

Superintendent Dr. Wendy Robinson nominated Roberts for the award. In her letter of recommendation, Robinson cited Roberts' dedication to his students, his strong work ethic and his creativity as qualities that make him an outstanding educator. "Mr. Roberts uses the universal language of technology to reach, influence and teach students of all cultures," Robinson said.

Mr. Roberts' passion was another factor in his selection. "The power of Todd's teaching is revealed in his zeal to engage ALL students in meaningful learning," Principal Matt Schiebel said.

A video was shown and Mr. Roberts was honored with a certificate and an engraved clock.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The current school site is significantly below the state minimum acreage recommendation. Funds are within budget. Purchases of properties in this block will allow flexibility for the school to expand parking lots or playing fields. Purchase prices of the properties are the average of two appraisals.

T-Mobile Central, LLC Communications Tower Lease – Snider High School Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the T-Mobile Central, LLC Communications Tower Lease – Snider High School:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve a lease between T-Mobile Central, LLC and Fort Wayne Community Schools – Snider High School for land on which to construct a communications tower and small building, and authorize the Superintendent to execute the lease.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** T-Mobile Central, LLC has offered to lease space at Snider High School for a payment of \$1000 per month for five years for the purpose of constructing a cellular communications tower. This lease is renewable for an additional rental payment after the initial term.

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Kurt A. Walborn, that the recommendation concerning the T-Mobile Central, LLC Communications Tower Lease – Snider High School be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Gifted and Talented Grant Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Gifted and Talented Grant:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a Gifted and Talented Grant for 2006-2007 from the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$71,366.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The state of Indiana provides non-competitive funds for districts to address the learning needs of high ability students. Funds for 2006-2007 will be used:

- To provide an appropriate education for identified high ability students through differentiated Levels of Service and program options; and
- To provide a special assignment GT Program Specialist to train teachers on the characteristics and educational needs of high ability students and on strategies for educating such students within the classroom.

Currently, gifted and talented services are delivered through the efforts of classroom teachers and supported by Thinking Skills Coaches in every building. The overall program is coordinated by Connie Collins in Curriculum Services.

The grant addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy 1: *We will ensure high levels of learning for all students.*

Reading is  
Fundamental  
Mini-Grants  
for Various  
Schools

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants for Various Schools:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants funded by the Indiana Department of Education in the total amount of \$20,025.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Thirteen (13) schools; Nine (9) Elementary - Adams, Bloomingdale, Bunche, Fairfield, Forest Park, Holland, Pleasant Center, Study, and Weisser; One (1) Intermediate - Towles; Two (2) Middle - Lane and Miami; and One (1) High – Elmhurst, are requesting to participate.

The goal of the Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants project is to promote recreational reading and home libraries for children who are at-risk. These mini-grants are designed to provide books to students, foster reading at home, and motivate students to develop a love of reading.

Requested funds will be used for the implementation of programs that (1) encourage parents to support their children's literacy development, (2) stimulate students' reading, (3) promote school-community partnerships, (4) encourage family literacy activities, and (5) provide three distributions of personal books for individual students.

This competitive program supports advancement intended and outlined in Strategy 1: *We will ensure high levels of learning for all students*, and Strategy 4: *We will function as a center of learning in the community.*

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Cable Fund Access Board Non-Access Channel Originator Grant from the Cable Fund Access Board in the amount of \$45,601.34 for Irwin Elementary School, North Side High School, Northwood Middle School and Wayne High School.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The objective of this request is to provide replacement equipment which will allow the video production studios to produce video to be used at the school, share with other schools, and be shown on the local cable access channel. The contact people for this competitive grant are Andra Rosene from Irwin, R. Scott Brown from North Side, Todd Roberts from Northwood, and Phil Morey from Wayne.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Best Buy Te@ch grant from the Best Buy Children’s Foundation in the amount up to \$15,000 for Franke Park Elementary School and \$2,500 for Brentwood Elementary School.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The objective of this request is to add technology to the existing curriculum and make learning fun. Students will use cameras to document knowledge in different areas, creating presentations and photo displays. The contact person for this competitive grant is Pam Ghaffarian from Franke Park Elementary School.

If awarded, Brentwood would use funds for technology equipment to support their science curriculum in motion and design. The contact person for Brentwood is Principal Get Nichols.
