Recognitions

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Lilly Teacher Creativity Fellowships Award **RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board recognize two FWCS teachers who have received 2016 Teacher Creativity Fellowship awards.

RELATED INFORMATION: Funded by Lilly Endowment, Inc., the Teacher Creativity Fellowship program enables teachers, principals, guidance counselors and school librarians from all over Indiana to take time to pursue their personal interests, explore subjects that intrigue them and just "get away." They return to school in the fall full of new ideas and wisdom to share with their students. Nearly 535 applied for awards across the state. Judges select winners from this very competitive pool of applicants. This year, two FWCS teachers received \$12,000 awards:

- R. Nelson Snider High School, Jennifer R. Walker, "Finding My Way along the Ring of Fire," spent three and a half weeks in the Galapagos Islands gathering photographic and geological samples for the classroom and participating in a research project. She will use the knowledge gained to create presentations of the biologic, volcanic and tectonic activity of this area of the Earth and use them to supplement projects and enhance the lectures she currently teaches.
- Waynedale Elementary School, Lisa A. Deck, "Just Breathe Naturally," began with a one-week art lesson with artists and was followed by four weeks in Switzerland, Germany and France, where she lived as a local, absorbing the cultures of her ancestry. Her last week was spent living alone in Paris and taking a five-day painting workshop known as Point Zero. She is now preparing a Point Zero workshop for Waynedale staff.

Purchase of Supplemental Reading Materials Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Purchase of Supplemental Reading Materials:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the use of Coordinated Early Intervening Services (CEIS) funds to purchase supplemental reading materials for elementary, middle, and high school students in the amount of \$326,698.31.

Booksource Inc. St. Louis, MO \$238,907.20

National Geographic Learning Independence, KY \$87,791.11

RELATED INFORMATION: CEIS are services provided to students in kindergarten through grade 12 who are not currently identified as needing special education or related services, but who need additional academic and behavioral supports to succeed in a general education environment. In support of the core curriculum, these supplemental reading materials will be provided to students in fourth, fifth, eighth, and ninth grades.

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, IDEA 2004, requires LEAs to use the maximum amount (15 percent) of funds allowable for comprehensive CEIS for children in the LEA.

These CEIS funds are managed by Tracy Williams, Chief Academic Officer, and support District Goal I: *Achieving and Maintaining Academic Excellence*.

A motion was made by Becky Hill, seconded by Julie Hollingsworth, that the recommendation concerning the Purchase of Supplemental Reading Materials be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Application for Common School Fund Loan Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Application for Common School Fund Loan:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of an advancement from the Indiana Common School Fund (CSF) for educational technology equipment in the amount of \$1,950,000.

RELATED INFORMATION: Advancements from the Common School Fund provide funds for school districts to purchase educational technology. The Fort Wayne Community Schools (FWCS) will use these moneys to help fund the FWCS technology plan previously submitted to the State.

Technology funds are currently insufficient to fund all the technology needs of the school corporation.

Funds are provided as a loan and are awarded to school corporations on the basis of assessed value (AV) per pupil, with low AV per pupil corporations receiving funds before high AV per pupil corporations. FWCS therefore cannot be assured of receiving the requested advancement.

Should the application be successful, funds will be budgeted in the Debt Service Fund to repay this loan beginning in the year 2018. Interest on the loan is expected to be no more than four percent and is likely to be as low as one percent.

Common School Fund advancements differ from School Technology Advancement Account (STAA) loans, which FWCS receives on an annual basis. Unlike CSF advancements, STAA advancements are given to all applying school corporations, regardless of their assessed value per pupil ranking.

Ratification of Fort Wayne Education Association Contract Reopener Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Ratification of Fort Wayne Education Association Contract Reopener:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board ratify the agreement reached with the Fort Wayne Education Association on the reopener of the Master Contract.

RELATED INFORMATION: The 2015-17 Master Contract contained a reopener for Separate Pay provisions in the summer of 2016. The parties began formal bargaining after the statutory date of August 1, and reached tentative agreement on September 14. FWEA ratified September 19. Agreed changes include index pay for Spell Bowl and Math Bowl coaches and summer programming pay.

A motion was made by Julie Hollingsworth, seconded by Anne Duff, that the recommendation concerning the Ratification of Fort Wayne Education Association Contract Reopener be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

2017 Budget Report Chief Financial Officer Kathy Friend will present a report that describes the year 2017 budgets for the General Fund and the eight tax supported funds: Racial Balance, Capital Projects, Transportation, Bus Replacement, Debt Service, Referendum Debt, Pension Bond, and Museum of Art. The public budget hearings will be held on October 10, 2016. Board action is scheduled for these budgets on October 24, 2016.

Board Member Steve Corona shared the story of the high school valedictorian who lost her financial assistance and scholarships after learning for the first time that she was an undocumented immigrant. The local group Latinos Count is helping the student with funds. President GiaQuinta shared the story and made a plea on behalf of the student during a local meeting of the Allen County Democratic Party. The group collected enough money to pay for books and more. Mr. Corona commented that there are so many more students in the same situation and we need to do something to help as a country.
