High Ability Grant

Dr. Daniel presented the following recommendation concerning the High Ability Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a High Ability Grant from the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$161,643.00 for the 2021-22 school year.

RELATED INFORMATION: The state of Indiana provides non-competitive funds for districts to address the learning needs of high ability students.

Currently, high ability services are delivered through the efforts of classroom teachers. The overall program is coordinated by Amelia Pflieger, Curriculum Coordinator of K-12 High Ability, Advanced Placement & Dual Credit and Fine Arts (Music & Art).

Lenovo ThinkPad Yoga 11e G5 Laptops Dr. Daniel presented the following recommendation concerning the Lenovo ThinkPad Yoga 11e G5 Laptops:

FWCS was able to secure pricing that was below General Services Administration (GSA) pricing. Indiana law does not require public bidding for purchases made at or below GSA pricing.

Funding will come from STAA (School Technology Advancement Account).

RELATED INFORMATION: I.C. 20-29-6-19 requires that this Board hold at least one public meeting "to discuss a tentative collective bargaining agreement" prior to ratification. FWCS properly noticed this public meeting and posted the tentative agreement between FWCS and the FWEA on the public website as required by the law.

Over the summer, teams from FWCS and the FWEA informally bargained their Contract and came to a tentative agreement. The most significant details are as follows:

- The salary range for all teachers will be \$42,306.00 to \$74,356.00 in the 2021-22 school year and \$43,998.00 to \$77,330.00 in the 2022-23 school year.
- The parties elected to maintain the current salary schedule, which will increase by 4% each year. As teachers progress on the schedule (based on evaluation and education), their pay will increase between 8.2% and 14.4% over two years.
- FWCS will continue to compensate teachers for classroom coverage to help manage a substitute teacher shortage.
- FWCS increased curriculum development and professional learning rates.
- FWCS increased the rates paid for cocurricular and athletic positions and added new positions including:
 - High school:
 - o Stipends for eSports programming
 - o Champions Together (Special Olympics)
 - o Special assignment orchestra and jazz band directors
 - o Student-athlete advisors
 - o Assistant vocal music director
 - o Assistant show choir director
 - o Assistant dance coach
 - Middle school:
 - o Team leaders at each level
 - o Theater, orchestra and dance directors
 - Elementary
 - o Flag football
- FWCS added assistant athletic coaches at every level to clean up the long-standing practice of splitting or sharing stipends to compensate additional staff.

This Board will meet on October 25, 2021, to ratify the Contract. Public comment will be taken at that meeting, as required by law. General Counsel David Amen and Chief Operations Officer, Charles Cammack, Jr. were available to answer questions.

The public meeting was opened at 6:45 p.m. Board members comments and questions were answered. The public meeting was closed at 6:56 p.m.

Mariachi Program at Lane Middle School The Mariachi program at Lane Middle School started in hopes of giving a voice to a growing population in our area, while allowing students to grow and learn about Mexican culture. Through this, they hope to breakdown cultural behaviors and grow appreciation for various music styles. Colleen Phillips, Lane Middle School band teacher and Bruce Schneider, b Instrumental Coordinator showed a video and were available to answer questions.

Comments

Board Member Rohli Booker, attended the South Side High School centennial kick off last week. This Friday is the "Green Out" homecoming vs. North Side. Member Booker also mentioned that Principal Swinford was voted 2nd best high school principal in Allen County. Ms. Booker did a shout out to Mr. Corona and the inspiring Latinos Count event that was held last week.

Board Member Jennifer Matthias, congratulated the Snider girls golf team and Coach for winning sectionals.

Board Member Noah Smith, commented that he appreciate the work legislators have done with regard to funding as this helped FWCS settle the FWEA teacher contract. Member Smith also thanked teachers, janitors and teacher assistants, for all their work during the COVID situation.

Superintendent Dr. Mark Daniel, also expressed thankfulness to Kathy Friend. FWCS is now able to compete for teachers across the Midwest in order to fill positions. FWCS appreciates the work our teachers do. Superintendent Daniel also thanked the teachers' union and the FWCS bargaining groups for making this a seamless process. This would not be possible without the help of the legislators.

Board President Anne Duff also did a shout out to Board Member Steve Corona for the virtual Latinos Count event. President Duff agrees that Principal Swinford deserves the award. Ms. Duff thanked FWCS teachers for everything they do. She also announced that the October 11, 2021, Board meeting is cancelled.
