Math Hero Award from MathMovesU **RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board recognize South Side High School teacher Matthew Toth for being awarded the Math Hero Award from MathMovesU, a national initiative from Raytheon Company.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Raytheon Company is committed to raising awareness for the importance of math and science skills. The Math Hero Award from MathMovesU rewards teachers and volunteers for promoting math to students in a fun and challenging learning environment. A hearing is scheduled for this evening's meeting of the Board of School Trustees. The intent of the hearing is to allow Board members the opportunity to receive community input. Board members will be asked to vote on these items on October 12, 2009.

This was the appropriate time for members of the public to address the Board regarding the 2010 budgets, the Capital Projects Plan and the 2010-2021 School Bus Replacement Plan. No one came before the Board to speak.
