Roll Call

The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday, October 8, 2007, at 6:02 p.m. President Stephen Corona called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and the following members in attendance:

Approval of Minutes – September 24, 2007 A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Mark GiaQuinta, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held September 24, 2007, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Vouchers

Dr. Robinson presented the vouchers for the period ending September 26, 2007, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Mitch Sheppard, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the vouchers appearing in the listing numbered 07-19 be approved without exception. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Goals for Expenditure Categories Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Goals for Expenditure Categories:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve a resolution to set expenditure category goals for the 2007-2008 school year. The goal is to strive to improve upon the current percentages between the expenditures for the student instructional categories and the other expenditure categories.

RELATED INFORMATION: Beginning with the 2007-08 school year, school districts are required to establish goals for each category of expenditures that will increase the school corporation's allocation of taxpayer resources directly to student instruction and learning, in light of the unique circumstances present in the school corporation.

The Department of Education reported that FWCS percentages for 2005-2006 were: Student Instructional Expenditures 68.8% (state average 62.0%) which includes:

- (1) student academic achievement expenditures 62.4%
- (2) student instructional support expenditures 6.4%

Other Expenditure Categories 31.2% (state average (38%), which includes:

- (3) overhead and operational expenditures 19.6%
- (4) non-operational expenditures 7.6%

OCTOBER 8, 2007 RESOLUTION FOR GOALS FOR EXPENDITURE CATEGORIES

WHEREAS, the Fort Wayne Community Schools Board of Trustees, Allen County, has adopted a 2008 budget; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 191-2006 states that beginning with the 2007-08 school year, each governing body shall establish goals for each category of expenditures that will increase the school corporation's allocation of taxpayer resources directly to student instruction and learning, in light of the unique circumstances present in the school corporation; and

WHEREAS, The State Board of Education has approved the following definitions:

A. "Student Instructional Expenditures" are: (1) student academic achievement expenditures plus (2) student instructional support expenditures.

B. "Other Expenditure Categories" are: (3) overhead and operational expenditures plus (4) non-operational expenditures; and

WHEREAS, Fort Wayne Community Schools believes funding for student instructional expenditures is a priority; and

WHEREAS, Fort Wayne Community Schools currently exceeds the state average in percentage of expenditures in that area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Fort Wayne Community Schools shall review on an annual basis each of these expenditure categories and how to improve student achievement. Fort Wayne Community Schools will strive to improve upon the current levels (percentages) between the expenditures for the student instructional expenditure categories and the other expenditure categories as described in IC 20-42.5 for the next fiscal year. However increasing the percentages in the student instructional expenditure categories and maintaining certain ratios between the "Student Instructional" and "Other Categories" may be negatively impacted by unique circumstances that the Fort Wayne Community Schools might experience such as, but not limited to:

- Loss or reduction of Federal & State Grants which require educational programs to be reduced or eliminated.
- Replacement of retiring teachers (top of the scale) with new teachers who have lower salaries than the retiring teachers.

School construction related to the district's long-range facility plan.

A motion was made by Kevin Brown, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the Goals for Expenditure Categories be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Indiana Regional Partnership Initiative Grant:

Indiana Regional Partnership Initiative Grant

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Indiana Regional Partnership Initiative grant from the Arts United of Greater Fort Wayne Indiana Arts Commission in the amount of \$5.140 for Memorial Park Middle School.

RELATED INFORMATION: The objective of this grant request is for the Jazz Mentorship to provide professional jazz artists to work with students in a one-week intensive music training program. The activities include private and ensemble lessons with the guest artists. The week will end with the students performing in several concerts. The contact person for this competitive grant is Donna Sevcovic, at Memorial Middle School.

This program supports advancement intended and outlined in Strategy 1: We will ensure high levels of learning for all students.

A motion was made by Mitch Sheppard, seconded by Kevin Brown, that the recommendation concerning the Indiana Regional Partnership Initiative Grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant:

High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant for 2007-2008 from the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$168,161.00.

RELATED INFORMATION: The state of Indiana provides non-competitive funds for districts to address the learning needs of high ability students. Funds for 2007-2008 will be used:

- To provide an appropriate education for identified high ability students through differentiated instruction (called Levels of Service) and program options; and
- To provide a special assignment High Ability Program Specialist to train teachers on the characteristics and educational needs of high ability students and on strategies for educating such students within the classroom.

Currently, high ability (gifted and talented) services are delivered through the efforts of classroom teachers and supported by Thinking Skills Coaches in every building. The overall program is coordinated by Nancy Stansberry in Curriculum Services.

The grant addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy 1: We will ensure high levels of learning for all students.

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Mark GiaQuinta, that the recommendation concerning the High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

AARP, The Ethel Percy Andrus Legacy Award for Innovation – Ward Education Center

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the AARP, The Ethel Percy Andrus Legacy Award for Innovation – Ward Education Center:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a grant for the Ward Education Center in the amount of \$10,000 from the AARP-Ethel Percy Andrus Legacy Award for Innovation.

RELATED INFORMATION: The grant application in the amount of \$10,000 will be awarded to one public secondary school (grades 8-12) in every state, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the US Virgin Islands in recognition of an innovative program or practice currently operating in a school. The award was developed to honor AARP's founder, Dr. Ethel Percy Andrus. The existing program or practice must have demonstrated successful innovation in the areas of student achievement or contributed to an improved environment for the students, the school, or the community served by the school, and must be no more than two years old. This award will go to the school; not the principal.

The challenge of Ward Education Center is to successfully service the academic, behavioral, social and interpersonal needs of those students who have been expelled from the district's high schools and middle schools, many of whom are classified as "at risk". This challenge has been taken head-on. The program goal will consist of three areas: (1) Literacy and its connection to student achievement; (2)

student introspection regarding their behavior and decision making and (3) accepting responsibility and acquiring skills necessary to be successful in life, school, work, and post working years.

The project will be implemented by Principal Gradlin Pruitt, Assistant Principal Jill Reynolds-Nixon, and teachers, David Sipples and Pam Teegardin, who are responsible for this grant which supports Strategy 1: We will ensure high levels of learning for all students.

A motion was made by Kevin Brown, seconded by Mitch Sheppard, that the recommendation concerning the AARP, The Ethel Percy Andrus Legacy Award for Innovation – Ward Education Center be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Reading is Fundamental Mini Grants for Various Schools Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Reading is Fundamental Mini Grants for Various Schools:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants funded by the Indiana Department of Education in the total amount of \$8,775.00

RELATED INFORMATION: Five (5) elementary schools – Bloomingdale, Fairfield, Irwin, South Wayne and Weisser Park are requesting to participate.

The goal of the Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants project is to promote recreational reading and home libraries for children who are at-risk. These mini-grants are designed to provide free paperback books to students, foster reading at home, and motivate students to develop a life-long love of reading.

Requested funds will be used for the implementation of programs that (1) enhance parent-student-school relationship by helping to promote a literate environment in the home; (2) support independent reading; (3) promote school-community partnerships; (4) give the students a sense of ownership; and (5) provide three distributions of personal books for individual students.

This competitive program supports advancement intended and outlined in Strategy 1 - We will ensure high levels of learning for all students, and Strategy 4 - We will function as a center of learning in the community.

A motion was made by Kevin Brown, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the Reading is Fundamental Mini Grants for Various Schools be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.
