**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize Darrell Jackson, a social studies teacher at Portage Middle School, for his contributions to the children and families of Fort Wayne Community Schools.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The Staff Spotlight program is the district's method of recognizing employees for outstanding work and commitment to excellence.

We honored Darrell Jackson, an FWCS teacher for seven years. He currently teaches seventh-grade social studies at Portage. In addition to teaching, Mr. Jackson is the boys track and junior varsity basketball coach at Snider. He also coaches sixth-grade football at Portage. Whether he's on the field or in the classroom, Mr. Jackson is known for encouraging students to reach their full potential.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Stewart B. McKinney - Vento Homeless Assistance Grant:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a grant for \$28,000 through the McKinney -Vento Act from the Indiana Department of Education. These funds will be used to support the Fort Wayne Community Schools Homeless Assistance Program.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Federal funding through the McKinney-Vento Act is one component of a program which would enable Fort Wayne Community Schools to provide assistance for students residing in shelters to continue their education. During the 2004-2005 school year, approximately 305 students were assisted through the program from 12 shelters and facilities in the community.

The funds are distributed as grants by the Indiana Department of Education for local education agencies to establish educational programs which promote the identification, enrollment, attendance, and success of homeless children and youth in school and preschool. The request of \$28,000 will be used to provide tutorial, remediation, instructional materials and supplies, and other related services to Fort Wayne Community Schools' homeless children and their families.

This competitive grant was prepared by Jerry White, Director of Student Services. The funds are used in support of Strategy 2: *We will provide a positive culture for students and staff.*

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Best Buy Te@ch Grant for \$2,500 and the Captain Planet Foundation Grant for \$2,500 for Franke Park Elementary School.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** If awarded, funds from the Captain Planet Grant will be used to improve awareness of the environment, and to teach the use of math and problem-solving skills in real-life, practical applications. Students will create and maintain gardens using math skills and conduct research on plants and the environment.

Funds from the Best Buy Te@ch Grant will be used to integrate technology use through the curriculum. Students will use curriculum to create simulations and develop problem-solving skills as they work cooperatively to survive the hardships.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** If awarded, funds from the JoAnn Fabrics grant will be used to create a space station pod in the classroom. Students will research what is needed to create an environment where people could survive in space.

The objective of the Office Depot grant request is to enhance science literacy and connection of concepts between home and school. Students will take home a bag containing a science-oriented book and items related to the science concept.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Funds from these grants will be used to integrate technology into the science curriculum, including space science, motion and design. Students will use concepts learned in the motion and design curriculum and the time curriculum to develop and design robots and planetary landscapes. Students will learn problem-solving skills needed to maneuver robots through a landscape while viewing the progress from a camera mounted on the robot.
