Purchase of Kenwood Digital Radios Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Purchase of Kenwood Digital Radios:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the purchase of Kenwood digital radios at all elementary schools, five middle schools, Anthis, Towles, and several support departments.

J & K Communications Columbia City, IN \$814,839.96

RELATED INFORMATION: This purchase is for a transition from all current district analog handheld radios and bus radios to digital radios, along with licensing, software, programming, Emergency Response System base units, and the replacement of existing analog repeaters. The transition to digital radios is required due to the Federal Communications Commission mandating the narrowing of the bandwidth. All high schools and five middle schools have already transitioned to digital handheld radios.

FWCS has standardized Kenwood brand radios for the compatibility of equipment and replacement parts, along with product quality and service. J & K Communications is the only authorized and approved Kenwood branded Land Mobile Radio sales dealer in Allen County and the surrounding area. As the local authorized sales dealer, the manufacturer, JVC Kenwood, requires that J & K Communications provide proper system design, installation, and ongoing support before, during, and after the sale. Sales to FWCS from a source other than J & K Communications would not be approved or supported by JVC Kenwood. Indiana law does not require a public bid process when these conditions are met.

This purchase will be paid from a combination of funds from Career Education, Nutrition Services, Transportation, and the General Fund.

A public budget presentation was made at the September 26, 2016 Board of School Trustees meeting. All nine Board adopted funds and proposed budgets were discussed, and estimated tax rates were reviewed. The capital projects plan and the bus replacement plan were properly advertised on September 27, 2016 in both newspapers. The budget was submitted to the Indiana Gateway on September 26, 2016 for public information.

According to Indiana law, the school corporation must conduct a public hearing on the budgets, the three-year capital projects plan and the twelve-year bus replacement plan. A hearing is scheduled for this evening's meeting of the Board of School Trustees. The intent of the hearing is to allow Board members the opportunity to receive community input. Board members will be asked to vote on these items on October 24, 2016.

This is the appropriate time for members of the public to address the Board regarding the 2017 budgets, the 2017-2019 Capital Projects Plan and the 2017-2028 School Bus Replacement Plan

Speaker

Brian Stooder had no comment on the FWCS budget, but wanted to thank Mark GiaQuinta and Kathy Friend for talking to the City Council regarding the Inventory Tax.

A motion was made by Becky Hill, seconded by Julie Hollingsworth, and supported by all, the hearing was closed.

Comments

Board Member Steve Corona shared information from the Redesign PD Partnership/Learning Forward's visit last week. The visitors to Fort Wayne were able to view the impressive work done at Lindley, South Side and observe more than 80 coaches collaborate with regard to Professional Learning that is embedded in our schedule.

Board Member Becky Hill also commented on the wonderful work FWCS has been doing and what she saw during the Redesign PD visit. This is a cultural change and we are formalizing a process.

Board Member Glenna Jehl was impressed with how teachers are working together and the respect they have for one another. Ms. Jehl also shared that she attended a School Board candidate forum at the Allen County Public Library. The question of how we can communicate better with our parents came up repeatedly.

Board Member Julie Hollingsworth also commented on the Redesign PD visit and she was fortunate to attend the dry run on Monday and she is not surprised on how well we were received. Ms. Hollingsworth congratulated Dr. Robinson and the FWCS staff.

President Mark GiaQuinta regrets he wasn't able to attend any of the Redesign PD visit. He questioned if this will make a difference to the students. President GiaQuinta has been working on the Superintendent's contract which he distributed to Board Members for review.

Next Meeting The next regular meeting of the Board is scheduled for Monday, October 24, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center.
