School Facility Awards Dr. Thomas Fowler-Finn, superintendent, presented the following recommendation concerning School Facility Awards:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize 10 schools with the highest-ranking building inspections for the 2001-02 school year.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Ensuring high standards of cleanliness and maintenance of FWCS buildings and grounds is a top priority for the Maintenance and Operations Department staff. Every year, their supervisors complete an inspection of each of our schools in order to keep custodial staff and principals informed about the condition of their building.

The inspections are then ranked numerically so that we may recognize those staffs that maintain their facilities in the best condition. This evening, we are recognizing the top two high schools, the top three middle schools and the top five elementary schools.

Purchase of Property -North Side High School Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation regarding the Purchase of Property - North Side High School:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board authorize the purchase of the following property located near North Side High School:

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The current school site is significantly below the state minimum acreage recommendation. The purchase price is the average of two appraisals. Funds are within budget.

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the recommendation concerning the Purchase of Property - North Side High School be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

North Side Renovation and Addition Project - Approval of Construction Contracts Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation regarding the North Side Renovation and Addition Project - Approval of Construction Contracts:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the following construction contracts for Phase I of the North Side Renovation and Addition Project:

## Bunn Excavating, Inc.

Package I Base Bid (site and aspnait paving)
Weigand Construction Co., Inc. Package 2 Base Bid (concrete)
Interstate Welding & Fabrication, Inc. Package 3 Base Bid (structural steel, steel joists, steel deck, and stairs)

TOTAL ALL CONTRACTS .......\$3,148,300

**RELATED INFORMATION:** This marks the beginning of Phase I of the North Side Renovation and Addition Project. Concrete foundation and structural steel work will start later this year and continue through the winter season. Site and asphalt paving work will create a parking area for students and staff, a bus drop-off and pick-up area, an underground water retention system, and a staging area for construction materials. With approval of this recommendation, the site and paving contractor will start construction and complete their work in December.

The budget for Phase I was estimated at \$4,000,000. These bids provide a savings of \$851,700. This could provide funds for other improvements at North Side not included in the base project if remaining phases are within budget.

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the recommendation regarding the North Side Renovation and Addition Project - Approval of Construction Contracts be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Saint Joseph Community Health Foundation Grant Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Saint Joseph Community Health Foundation grant:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a \$750.00 grant from the Saint Joseph Community Health Foundation to purchase emergency supplies for diabetic students.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Treatment protocols for diabetes have improved the long term outcome for people with diabetes. These protocols require frequent blood testing and treatment. Parents are expected to provide the school with the supplies needed for this care. However, it is necessary for the school to have the testing equipment in the event that the parent forgets. This money will be used to allow Health Services to furnish these supplies when necessary.

This grant addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy III, Safe and Caring Environment.

A motion was made by Donald J. Schaab, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the Saint Joseph Community Health Foundation grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Smokefree Allen County, Inc. Grant Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Smokefree Allen County, Inc. Grant:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Smokefree Allen County School-Based Partnership grant sponsored by the Indiana Tobacco Prevention and Cessation Agency. This grant is \$16,000 per year for two years, totaling \$32,000.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Funds for this grant will fund training sessions for eleven school nurses, which will allow each FWCS high school and middle school nurse to offer the "Tobacco Education Group" and "Tobacco Awareness Program for Youth Cessation" programs to students. The grant will also enable the continuation of the Snider High School SWAT team, add a "Teens as Teachers" peer education group at Lane Middle School, and initiate a "Resistance Against Tobacco" for Adams and Glenwood elementary schools grades 3, 4, and 5. The grant will also provide a "Be Tobacco Free" education program for six elementaries.

This non-competitive grant will be submitted by Becky Talati, Health Services Specialist. It addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy III, Safe and Caring Environment and Strategy X, Community Linkages.

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the recommendation regarding the Smokefree Allen County, Inc. Grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants funded by the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$7,125.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The goal of the Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants project is to increase the literacy of Pre-Kindergarten through Grade Three students. These mini-grants are designed to provide books to students, foster reading at home, and motivate students to develop a love of reading.

Grant applications are being submitted by the following elementary schools: Abbett (\$1125), Arlington (\$675), Harrison Hill (\$1425), Irwin (\$675), Scott Academy (\$1275), South Wayne (\$825), and Young (\$1125).

Requested funds will be used for the implementation of programs that (1) encourage parents to support their children's literacy development, (2) stimulate students' reading, (3) promote school-community partnerships, (4) encourage family literacy activities, and (5) provide personal books for individual students.

The mini-grants address advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education; and Strategy VI, Meaningful Relationships with Families. Coordination of the grants rests with individual principals and Sandy Sunderland-Willis.

A motion was made by Donald J. Schaab, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the Reading is Fundamental Mini-Grants be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Cable Fund Access Board Grants Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Cable Fund Access Board Grants:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of grants in the amount totaling \$39,494.00 from the Cable fund Access Board for Anthis Career Center, North Side High School, Wayne High School, and Croninger Elementary School.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Schools submit grant requests to the Cable fund Access Board for the purchase of television production equipment to be used in producing programs for the cable access channels. These competitive grants have been submitted by:

A motion was made by Donald J. Schaab, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the Cable Fund Access Board Grants be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

GRAMMY Foundation Grant for Weisser Park Elementary Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation regarding the GRAMMY Foundation Grant for Weisser Park Elementary:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve GRAMMY Foundation for \$2,500 for Weisser Park elementary school.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The GRAMMY Foundation, a non-profit arm of the Recording Academy, recognizes and rewards elementary schools that promote and preserve music education as a key part of their curriculum for all students. The highly competitive grant process for this award includes narrowing 6,600 applications to 300 finalist schools who then submit cassette tape of examples

of performing groups from the schools. Of those 300, nine will be designated as Signature "Gold" schools and awarded a stipend. One will be chosen as the top school in the country.

If awarded, the stipend would be used to aid the purchase of two tympani drums for Weisser Park School which currently has more than 400 students participating in the Instrumental Music Program.

Music teacher, Laura McCoy is responsible for this grant which addresses advancement intended and outlined in the Fort Wayne Community Schools Strategic Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees. Specifically, Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education, and Strategy VII, Student-Centered Environment.

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the GRAMMY Foundation Grant for Weisser Park Elementary be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

#### Gifted and Talented Grant

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation regarding the Gifted and Talented Grant:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a Gifted and Talented Grant for 2002-2003 from the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$70,281.00.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The state of Indiana provides non-competitive funds for districts to address the learning needs of high ability students. Funds for 2002-2003 will be used to

- Provide an appropriate education for identified high ability students, and
- To train teachers on the characteristics and educational needs of high ability students, and on strategies for educating such students within the classroom.

Currently, gifted and talented services are delivered through the efforts of classroom teachers and supported by Thinking Skills Coaches in every building. The overall program is coordinated by Henrietta Howell in Curriculum Services.

The grant addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education and Strategy VII, Student-centered Environment.
