**RELATED INFORMATION**: A public budget presentation was made at the September 28, 2015 Board of School Trustees meeting. ### RESOLUTION OCTOBER 26, 2015 TO ADOPT THE 2016 CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND PLAN

This resolution is adopted by the Board of School Trustees of The Fort Wayne Community Schools, Allen County, Indiana.

WHEREAS a School Capital Projects Fund has been established, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is required under I.C. 20-46-6-5 to adopt a plan with respect to the capital projects fund; and

## REDUCTION OF CERTAIN CAPITAL PROJECTS IN THE CAPITAL PROJECT FUND

## (RESOLUTION)

WHEREAS there is a need to reduce certain Capital Projects Fund (CPF) projects, WHEREAS such a reduction is necessary prior to reappropriation of unspent funds, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools in Allen County, Indiana that the Capital Projects on the attached page be closed.

A motion was made by Julie Hollingsworth, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Closing of Capital Projects in the Capital Projects Fund be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

## Levy Neutrality

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Levy Neutrality:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve reductions to the 2016 budgets of the Bus Replacement Fund and the Capital Projects Fund Plan to support the tax neutrality requirements of the Pension Bond.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Public Law 199 requires that those districts, who issue a pension bond to replace their retirement severance programs, must make the annual bond payment a tax neutral event to taxpayers. As a result, Fort Wayne Community Schools has chosen to reduce the levies in the Bus Replacement Fund and the Capital Projects Fund Plan. With this reduction the district will purchase fourteen fewer buses and will reduce the Capital Projects Fund Plan.

#### RESOLUTION OCTOBER 26, 2015 PENSION BOND FUND LEVY NEUTRALITY

This resolution is adopted by the Board of School Trustees of The Fort Wayne Community Schools, Allen County, Indiana.

WHEREAS the Pension Bond Fund expected levy of \$3,460,347 needs to be tax neutral. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the tax levies of Bus Replacement Fund and Capital Projects Fund will be reduced. It is expected that the tax levies will be reduced as follows:

Capital Projects Fund \$2,000,000 Bus Replacement Fund \$1,460,347

The Board further agrees that any levy greater than \$3,460,347 will be reduced from the Bus Replacement Fund.

A motion was made by Glenna Jehl, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Levy Neutrality be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Goals for Expenditure Categories Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Goals for Expenditure Categories:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve a resolution to set expenditure category goals for the 2015-2016 school year. The goal is to improve upon the current percentages between the expenditures for the student instructional categories and the other expenditure categories.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Beginning with the 2007-2008 school year, school districts were required to establish goals for each category of expenditures that will increase the school corporation's allocation of taxpayer resources directly to student instruction and learning, in light of the unique circumstances present in the school corporation. The Department of Education reported the following percentages:

FWCS student instructional expenditures as a percent of the total decreased due to 2012 referendum expenditures. However, FWCS is 4.3 percentage points greater than the state average.

## OCTOBER 26, 2015 RESOLUTION FOR GOALS FOR EXPENDITURE CATEGORIES

WHEREAS, the Fort Wayne Community Schools Board of Trustees, Allen County, has adopted a 2016 budget;

WHEREAS, P.L. 191-2006 states that beginning with the 2007-08 school year, each governing body shall establish goals for each category of expenditures that will increase the school corporation's allocation of taxpayer resources directly to student instruction and learning, in light of the unique circumstances present in the school corporation.

WHEREAS, The State Board of Education has approved the following definitions:

A. "Student Instructional Expenditures" are: (1) student academic achievement expenditures plus (2) student instructional support expenditures.

B. "Other Expenditure Categories" are: (3) overhead and operational expenditures plus (4) non-operational expenditures.

WHEREAS, Fort Wayne Community Schools believes that the educational preparation of all students be addressed in a manner that maximizes the individual student's potential.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Fort Wayne Community Schools shall review on an annual basis each of these expenditure categories and how to improve student achievement. Fort Wayne Community Schools will strive to improve upon the current levels (percentages) between the expenditures for the student instructional expenditure categories and the other expenditure categories as described in IC 20-42.5 for the next fiscal year. However increasing the percentages in the student instructional expenditure categories and maintaining certain ratios between the "Student Instructional" and "Other Categories" may be negatively impacted by unique circumstances that the Fort Wayne Community Schools might experience such as, but not limited to:

- Changes in Federal & State Grants.
- Replacement of retiring teachers (top of the scale) with new teachers who have lower salaries than the retiring teachers.
- School construction related to the district's long-range facility plan.

A motion was made by Julie Hollingsworth, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Goals for Expenditure Categories be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Indiana law requires that projects over \$100,000 make use of a registered architect or a professional engineer for developing plans and specifications. Project architects/engineers need to be appointed now to allow sufficient time for planning and bidding of the projects to ensure the starting of these projects in the summer of 2016.

#### Comments

Board Member Glenna Jehl commented on the announcement that the United States Department of Education is looking at ways to reduce student time spent on testing. She thinks this is a good thing.

Board Member Becky Hill commented about her trip to Indianapolis with other Board members to talk with Legislators about the teacher shortage. She found it an interesting and educational experience.

Board Member Julie Hollingsworth also went to Indianapolis and was able to testify before the legislative committee. She shared her testimony with Board members. She is saddened that legislators are not outraged that test scores are expected to go down 10-15%. Ms. Hollingsworth commented about her visits to Shawnee and Jefferson Middle Schools. She also visited Northrop High School where the Planetarium is up and running again.

Board Member Anne Duff also went to Indianapolis for the legislative meeting. She submitted her comments to legislators via email about the effects of the teacher shortage on her family and children.

Board President Mark GiaQuinta thanked those Board members who traveled to Indianapolis to represent Fort Wayne Community Schools. Mr. GiaQuinta thanked the legislators who represent our district for listening and acting upon our needs. Mr. GiaQuinta thanked Melanie Hall and Krista Stockman from Public Affairs for another successful Principal for a Day program.
