### Title II, Part A Grant

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of funds from the Indiana Department of Education for Title II, Part A grant in the amount of \$1,951,702.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Title II funding is provided to schools under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). The allocation is based on enrollments for both public and private schools in the FWCS attendance area. An amount of \$184,146.00 has been allocated to serve identified private schools for Title II, Part A.

Title II is an entitlement grant provided to supplement the General Fund. Monies from Title II, Part A will be used to reduce class size and provide teacher training in core academic subjects. The grant is used for teachers of all grade levels.

This noncompetitive grant is coordinated by Ramona Coleman of Professional Development and addresses advancement intended and outlined in Goal I: *Achieve and maintain academic excellence* 

Stewart B. McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Grant

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a grant for \$45,000 through the Indiana Department of Education McKinney-Vento Act. These funds will be used to support the Fort Wayne Community Schools' Homeless Assistance Program.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Federal funding through the McKinney-Vento Act is one component of a program which enables FWCS to provide assistance for students residing in shelters to continue their education. During the 2009-2010 school year, approximately 356 students were assisted through the program from eight shelters and several hotels/motels in the community.

The funds are distributed as grants by the Indiana Department of Education for local education agencies to establish educational programs which promote the identification, enrollment, attendance, and success of homeless children and youth in school and preschool. The request of \$45,000 will be used to provide support, remediation, instructional materials and supplies, and other related services to Fort Wayne Community Schools' homeless children and their families.

This competitive grant was prepared by Craig Martin, Director of Student Services, and supports FWCS Goal I: *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence*.

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that an award be made to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder meeting specifications and quality standards.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: I.C. 20-26-7-37 as amended (P.L. 1028) requires that a public hearing be conducted for all building projects costing \$1,000,000 or more that would be financed by issuing bonds.
