Title IV Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities Grant **RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Title IV Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities Grant from the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$214,296.00.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Title IV funding is provided to schools under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). The allocation is based on enrollments for both public and non-public schools in the FWCS attendance area. An amount of \$36,440.10 has been allocated to non-public schools for Title IV.

This Title IV grant is an entitlement grant provided to supplement the general fund. Monies from Title IV will be used to provide an interactive program that instructs students about thinking patterns and how thinking errors can lead to irresponsible behavior.

Charles Green, Pyramid for Success<sup>TM</sup>, is the coordinator of this non-competitive grant. Funds are used in support of FWCS Goal II: *We will provide a positive culture for students and staff*.

Title II, Part A Grant

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of funds from the Indiana Department of Education for Title II, Part A grant in the amount of \$2,008,160.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Title II funding is provided to schools under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). The allocation is based on enrollments for both public and private schools in the FWCS attendance area. An amount of \$201,758.00 has been allocated to serve identified private schools for Title II, Part A.

Title II is an entitlement grant provided to supplement the general fund. Monies from Title II, Part A will be used to reduce class size and provide teacher training in core academic subjects. The grant is used for teachers of all grade levels.

This noncompetitive grant is coordinated by Linda Roman of Professional Development and addresses advancement intended and outlined in Goal I: *Achieve and maintain academic excellence*.

Consent Agenda A motion was made by Mitch Sheppard, seconded by Kevin Brown, that the following items on the consent agenda be approved: Minutes of the regular Board meeting of October 26, 2009; vouchers covering the period ending November 9, 2009; personnel report; Title IV Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities Grant; and Title II, Part A Grant.

Community Programs Report

Coordinator of Community Programs Sharon Callender provided information about district programs/initiatives of Community Programs and how they align with the three district goals.

Board member Kevin Brown thanked the Public Affairs Department for the successful Principal for a Day event. Mr. Brown visited Principal Jeff Cline at Fairfield Elementary and suggests we invite Governor Daniels next year. Mr. Brown also commented about the need to build a positive image for Ward Education Center. Lastly, Mr. Brown would like to encourage those who bring problems forward, to suggest a solution.

Board member Steve Corona commented about attending a groundbreaking ceremony in Columbus, IN for the Advanced Manufacturing Center of Excellence funded by a Lilly grant. Mr. Corona remarked that Indiana is one of 12 states that does not fund pre-school education and he thinks the state will not be able to lead in business until we do so.

Board member Pamela Martin-Diaz thanked the administration for the work done to bring back parent / teacher conferences to schools. She also thanked the teachers and staff at schools who worked long days to have conferences. While visiting schools Ms. Martin-Diaz saw Data Walls and sensed the urgency in staff and students to learn and track.

Superintendent Robinson commented on the Cambridge visit to North Side and South Side high schools. Cambridge was hired by the state to evaluate and we understand Cambridge will provide a preliminary report in early December. We will respond when the report comes to us, but we already know about and are addressing problems through the high school reinvent project.

Superintendent Robinson reported that details for the "Race to the Top" federal funds are not final, but FWCS will apply for any funds for which we are eligible.

President GiaQuinta would like information about students returning to FWCS from charter schools and any remediation needed.

President GiaQuinta also congratulated Superintendent Robinson who will be honored at the annual conference of the National Alliance of Black School Educators (NABSE) on November 21. Dr. Robinson will receive the Joseph E. Hill Superintendent of the Year Award.

President GiaQuinta commented about working on the Superintendent's contract and evaluation. He would like to have a Board committee work with the Superintendent to create an evaluation tool. He asked Board members Pamela Martin-Diaz, Mitch Sheppard and John Peirce to sit in this committee.
