Approval of Minutes – October 27, 2003

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Indiana State Band Competition **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize bands from North Side and Snider high schools for placing in the top 10 in state band competition.

RELATED INFORMATION: Schools from across the state participated in the annual band competition, sponsored by the Indiana State School Music Association, on October 25, 2003, in Indianapolis.

Snider placed 10th in Class A competition and North Side placed sixth in Class B competition. Snider placed fourth in regional competition in Chesterton and North Side placed third in regional competition in Carmel.

RELATED INFORMATION: The phase II portion of the North Side project consists of interior renovations and the addition of cafeteria, gymnasium, and classroom spaces. These alternates have been held as other options have been considered. This recommendation is within the project budget, which is funded from the bond issue by the North Side High School Building Corporation. These alternates will not extend the completion date of August 2005.

Foellinger Foundation – Youth Worker Training Project Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Foellinger Foundation – Youth Worker Training Project:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Foellinger Foundation – Youth Worker Training Project in the amount of \$2,947.60 for Arlington, \$12,000.00 for Forest Park and \$6,000.00 for Indian Village Elementary Schools.

<u>Arlington</u>: The objective of this grant request is to draw out from students the traits they feel are important in the adults that work with them. Fifth grade students will brainstorm on ideas of character traits and create a book with illustration based on the trait learned. The school will purchase a digital

camera and the necessary supplies to produce a book. The funding of this grant will provide materials and supplies to create the book. Janet Corah, art teacher, is the contact for this grant.

<u>Forest Park</u>: The objective of this grant request is to engage fifth graders in a six-week study about heroes with special focus on the adults in our students' lives who make a difference for them. This will include work with literature, famous Americans, and interviews with local heroes and school staff. The funding of this grant will provide the materials to support the literature study, field trips, and speakers. Toni Kring, the principal at Forest Park, is the contact person for this grant.

<u>Indian Village</u>: The objective of this grant request is to purchase 100 copies of the book entitled, *Finding Fish*, by Antwone Fisher. Fifth grade students will learn from this true story that against all odds, it is still possible to always make good choices. As students work through the story they will be given various writing assignments, will enter into a variety of small and large group discussions, improve speech and communication skills, and through these activities the ability to think through a problem.

The approval of this grant will also provide motivational speakers that would echo the good choices for life theme. Stephanie Bourne, the principal at Indian Village, is the contact person for this grant.

The competitive grant supports advancement intended and outlined in Strategy VII, Student-Centered Environment.

<u>Weisser Park</u>: The objective of this grant request is to enable 5th grade students to experience, discover, and learn about qualities in adults that inspire young people. The students will observe positive and negative interpersonal adult relationships in our Fort Wayne area. The school will purchase a digital camera, and other materials and supplies for some of their projects – Camp Potawotami, service project at Charis House, speakers, and literature books to study meaningful qualities they come to value in story characters.

The competitive grant supports advancement intended and outlined in Strategy VII, Student-Centered Environment.
