High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant for 2014-2015 from the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$150,192.00.

RELATED INFORMATION: The state of Indiana provides non-competitive funds for districts to address the learning needs of high ability students. Funds for 2014-2015 will be used:

- To provide an appropriate education for identified high ability students through differentiated services and program options; and
- To continue to provide a Curriculum Coordinator to train teachers on the characteristics and
 educational needs of high ability students and on strategies for educating such students within
 the classroom.

Currently, high ability (gifted and talented) services are delivered through the efforts of classroom teachers. The overall program is coordinated by Amelia Pflieger, Curriculum Coordinator in Academic Services.

This grant addresses Goal 1: Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence.

Group Health Plan Renewal Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Group Health Plan Renewal:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board renew the administration contract with Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield effective January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015.

RELATED INFORMATION: Anthem acts as a third party administrator for the FWCS Group Health Plan, providing employees with access to broad-based PPO providers and network discounts. In addition, they manage claims processing services and all aspects of the provider network, perform utilization and medical management functions, and provide enrollment support and customer service for our employees.

Administrative fees for medical, dental and vision are increasing 3% or about \$38,034. Reinsurance premiums are increasing 6% or about \$87,446. Administrative fees and reinsurance premiums are \$2.9 million or approximately 6.3% of the total expected cost of the health plan, \$45.5 million.

Upon a motion by Stephen Corona, seconded by Jordan Lebamoff and agreed to by all, the recommendations concerning the 2013-2014 Stipend for Non-Teacher Employees and Teacher Base Salary Increase were voted upon with one motion.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendations concerning the 2013-2014 Stipend for Non-Teacher Employees and Teacher Base Salary Increase:

2013-2014 Stipend for Non-Teacher Employees **RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve a stipend for the 2013-14 contract year for all non-teacher employees and further recommend that the Board authorize the Superintendent to determine the stipends for eligible AFSCME, Fort Wayne Classified Association, Fort Wayne Nurses Association, Teamsters and non-teacher employees not represented by a collective bargaining group.

RELATED INFORMATION: Stipends are being provided to teachers, principals and assistant principals through the Teacher Incentive Fund (TIF) Grant. It is desirable to provide stipends to other employees as well. Employees must have been paid for 120 days during the 2013-14 school year and currently employed in order to be eligible. These stipends will be allocated to the funds that employees are normally paid from.

Teacher Base Salary Increase

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve base salary increases for eligible teachers for the 2014-15 school year.

RELATED INFORMATION:

- 1. Teachers completing 3-21 years of FWCS experience prior to the 2014-15 school year and rated effective or highly effective shall receive a 3% increase to base salaries.
- 2. Teachers completing 22 or more years of FWCS experience prior to the 2014-15 school year and rated effective or highly effective shall receive a 2% increase to base salaries.
- 3. All increases above shall be retroactive to the beginning of the 2014-15 school year for described teachers on active payroll as of the date of Board approval.

Eligible teachers will also receive TIF Stipends that were negotiated and approved by the Board on August 28, 2013 for the 2013-2014 school year that include:

Effective: \$2100 Highly Effective: \$2600

Appointment of Common Wage Committee Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Appointment of Common Wage Committee:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board appoint the following members to the FWCS Common Wage Committee:

Bill Bean, representing industry Charles Heiny, a taxpayer in the FWCS district

RELATED INFORMATION: FWCS must conduct a Common Wage hearing to determine the most common wage for each class of work on projects over \$350,000 in 2015. The projects must be bid within 90 days of the meeting. The common wage determines the minimum wage to be paid on upcoming FWCS construction projects.

By statute, there are five members of the Common Wage Committee. Three appointments are external, including one representing labor, one named by Associated Builders & Contractors, and one appointed by the County. Two members are appointed by FWCS, one representing industry and one taxpayer in Allen County who will pay taxes for the project

A motion was made by Julie Hollingsworth, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Appointment of Common Wage Committee be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Board members commented about the successful Showcase at Northrop High School that was held on November 8^{th} .

Board member Julie Hollingsworth thanked Melanie Hall and Public Affairs for hosting a very successful tour for Resor Relators. Julie also congratulated Snider for winning in football sectionals and North Side High School for getting 10th in State in Band competition.

Board President Mark GiaQuinta shared that he attended a meeting with Chief Financial Officer Kathy Friend and community members about the role of the Chamber in helping with public education. It is good to have these individuals champion our schools. He also thanked and congratulated schools that work hard every day to make sure students succeed.

Superintendent Wendy Robinson reminded people that students are in school on Veteran's Day and many classes do activities to learn about and honor Veterans.
