Approval of Minutes – October 28, 2002

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held October 28, 2002, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Thomas Fowler-Finn, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Delayed High School Diploma **RECOMMENDATION:** This marks a first for Fort Wayne Community Schools, as we presented a high school diploma to World War II veteran John L. Byers. Mr. Byers was drafted into the Army Air Force during his senior year at North Side High in December of 1943. A new federal law that took effect this past July established a method to award a high school diploma to honorably discharged veterans of World War I and World War II. Mr. Byers is the first from FWCS to apply for this delayed high school diploma.

We are very proud to honor Mr. Byers with a high school diploma, one he would have received in 1944 had the war not intervened. And, we want to thank him for his service to this country.

Mr. Byers came forward so the Superintendent could make a presentation.

State Band Competition **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize three high school bands for their success in state competition.

Staff Spotlight -Christine Davis, teacher, South Wayne **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize Christine Davis, teacher at South Wayne Elementary School, for her contributions to the children and families of Fort Wayne Community Schools.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Staff Spotlight program is the district's method of recognizing employees for outstanding work and commitment to excellence. Tonight we honor Christine Davis, kindergarten teacher at South Wayne Elementary School for her innovative teaching and dedication to ensuring all students achieve. A teacher with the district since 1971, she has taught at South Wayne for the past 28 years, providing families of her students with a sense of stability, continuity and consistency.

A video highlighting her accomplishments was shown.

This program addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy V, Ensuring Staff Effectiveness; and Strategy VIII, Communicating that FWCS is an Excellent School System.

Weisser Park Magnet Presentation From academics to fine arts, Weisser Park Elementary School is using technology to enhance student achievement. Principal Dan Bickel discussed the school's successes in incorporating technology into this magnet school's program.

RELATED INFORMATION: FWCS makes two appointments to the Library board. Dolores Klocke has been serving since October 1999. Her new term will begin January 1, 2003, and end December 31, 2006.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Naming of Snider Gym:

Naming of Snider Gym

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board name Snider's gym floor in the main gymnasium in honor of Lamar Kilmer, deceased coach and teacher.

RELATED INFORMATION: Mr. Kilmer taught and coached at Snider for over a quarter of a century. Under his direction, leadership, and instruction of the girls' basketball program at Snider for 21 years, the "LAMAR'S GIRLS" won nine sectionals, six regionals, and three semi-states in addition to their excellent showing at the state level. He had also coached the boy's tennis team.

The proposal has been unanimously approved by the Snider Coaches' Council, PTA, School Improvement Team, teachers, students, and staff. It is believed by all that Mr. Kilmer touched the lives and educational achievement of thousands of students in the classroom. It is only fitting and proper that Snider High School should honor his memory and contribution in an appropriate and lasting manner.

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Donald J. Schaab, that the recommendation concerning the Naming of Snider Gym be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Salary Increase for FWEA Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Salary Increase for FWEA:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board ratify a one percent (1%) salary increase for the 2002/2003 contract year for Fort Wayne Education Association (FWEA) representing teachers.

RELATED INFORMATION: On May 13, 2002, the Board ratified a one year contract extension between Fort Wayne Community Schools (FWCS) and Fort Wayne Education Association (FWEA). This extension included an agreement to provide a salary increase determined by an agreed upon formula or 1%, whichever was greater. After completion of the formula calculations, it has been determined that 1% is the greater amount.

A motion was made by Donald J. Schaab, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the Salary Increase for FWEA be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Non-Union Salary Increase Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Non-Union Salary Increase:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve a one percent (1%) salary increase for the 2002/2003 school year for Salary Schedules I, II, and III, Meet & Confer groups and other non-union groups on school-year agreements. Increases will be consistent with the appropriate contracts and language agreements for each non-union group.

It is further recommended that the Board approve a one percent (1%) salary increase effective January 1, 2003 for all other Meet & Confer and non-union groups not otherwise covered by alternative agreements.

It is also recognized that the Superintendent may bring forward adjustments on policy/agreement language to be submitted for approval at a later time.

RELATED INFORMATION: This pay increase was calculated using the same formula agreed upon for teachers.

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Carl A. Johnson, that the recommendation concerning the Non-Union Salary Increase be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Approval of North Side High School Construction Plans Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Approval of North Side High School Construction Plans:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the construction plans and specifications for the North Side High School addition and renovation. The approved plans and specifications will be used as the basis for requesting bids on the project.

RELATED INFORMATION: SchenkelShultz, the architects for the project, recently presented the construction plans and specifications to the board in small group meetings. At that time the board had an opportunity to review the detailed plans and to provide input.

A motion was made by Donald J. Schaab, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the Approval of North Side High School Construction Plans be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Acceptance of Property for North Side High School Project Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Acceptance of Property for North Side High School Project:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board accept property from CARS-DB3, L.P. for the benefit of the North Side High School project.

RELATED INFORMATION: A certain portion of Fricke Avenue was vacated with City Council approval. When a street is vacated, ownership is divided between the two adjacent property owners. Although North Side acquired one half of the street, the other half was also needed to accomplish the needs of the project. Kelley Chevrolet is housed on the other adjacent property which is owned by CARS-DB3, L.P. Mr. Jim Kelley was instrumental in encouraging CARS-DB3, L.P. to convey the property to North Side High School. CARS-DB3, L.P. agreed to make a charitable contribution of the property to North Side.

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the recommendation concerning the Acceptance of Property for North Side High School Project be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Bid Recommendation for Uniform Rental and Dust Control Items, P/B #8175:

Bid Recommendation for Uniform Rental and Dust Control Items, P/B #8175

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that an award be made to the lowest responsible bidder meeting specifications:

Van Dyne-Crotty, Incorporated, Fort Wayne, IN \$136,721.00

RELATED INFORMATION: The bid is for a two-year contract, with an option to extend for a period not longer than the original contract term. The bid is for rental garments for the custodians, mechanics, and other personnel for whom FWCS furnishes uniforms by contractual agreement. The bid also includes walk-off mats, shop towels, and dust mops.

Invitations to Bid were mailed to seven prospective bidders with four responding. Bids were provided by Aramark Uniform Services, Fort Wayne, IN; Cintas Corporation, Fort Wayne, IN; Van Dyne-Crotty, Incorporated, Fort Wayne, IN; and Wildman Uniform & Linen, Warsaw, IN.

The following companies did not respond: Domestic Uniform Rental, Fort Wayne, IN; Unitog, Fort Wayne, IN; and Wearguard, Norwell, MA.

The bids were reviewed in detail by the Maintenance & Operations Department and the Purchasing Department.

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the Bid Recommendation for Uniform Rental and Dust Control Items, P/B #8175 be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Title II Grants:

Title II Grants

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of funds from the Indiana Department of Education for Title II, Part A and Title II, Part D grants in the amounts of \$1,889,642 and \$210,238 respectively.

RELATED INFORMATION: Title II funding is provided to schools under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). The allocation is based on enrollments for both public and non-public schools in the FWCS attendance area. An amount of \$61,766 has been allocated to serve identified non-public schools for Title II, Part A and \$21,378 has been allocated to serve identified non-public schools for Title II, Part D.

Title II is an entitlement grant provided to supplement the general fund. Monies from Title II, Part A will be used to reduce class size and provide teacher training in core academic subjects. Monies from Title II, Part D will be used to provide professional development and materials to enhance the use of instructional technology. Both portions of the grant are used for teachers of all grade levels.

The grant addresses the advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education; and Strategy V. Ensuring Staff Effectiveness. Title II, Part A is coordinated by Bob Trammel and Part D is coordinated by Joanne Schafer, both of Curriculum Services.

A motion was made by Donald J. Schaab, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the Title II Grants be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Title III Grant Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Title III Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of funds from the Indiana Department of Education for Title III Language Instruction for Limited English Proficient and Immigrant Students in the amount of \$135,135.

RELATED INFORMATION: Title III is an entitlement grant and a new source of funding provided to schools under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). The allocation is based upon enrollment of Limited English Proficient (LEP) students in the district and supplements the general fund. The grant provides:

- Additional classroom assistance for existing ESL programs;
- Additional translation services for non-English speaking students and their families;
- Additional hours for evaluators to determine the degree of language development support needed by each qualifying student; and
- Professional development for ESL teachers and for general education teachers of ESL students.

The grant addresses the advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education; and Strategy V, Staff Effectiveness, and is coordinated by Henrietta Howell, Manager of Extended Learning, in Curriculum Services.

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the recommendation concerning the Title III Grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Title V Grant Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Title V Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of funds from the Indiana Department of Education for Title V Innovative Programs in the amount of \$275,321.

RELATED INFORMATION: Title V funding is provided to schools under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) and replaces the previous Title VI funding source. The allocation is based on enrollments for both public and non-public schools in the FWCS attendance area. An amount of \$165,307 has been allocated to serve identified non-public schools.

Title V is an entitlement grant provided to supplement the general fund. Monies from Title V will be used to support Reading Recovery and provide teacher training in the district instructional models in the core academic subjects.

The grant addresses the advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education; and Strategy V. Ensuring Staff Effectiveness, and is coordinated by Sandy Sunderland-Willis of Curriculum Services.

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Donald J. Schaab, that the recommendation concerning the Title V Grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

2002 ITT Industries Excellence in Education Award Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the 2002 ITT Industries Excellence in Education Award:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the 2002 ITT Industries Excellence in Education Award from the Allen County Local Education Fund in the amount of \$1,500 for Northcrest Elementary and of \$750.00 Northwood Middle Schools.

RELATED INFORMATION: The objective of this non-competitive grant is to support creative and effective teaching methods and ideas to keep students interested and involved in the strengthening of their academic achievements. James Ewing and Rafael Colon are responsible for this grant for Northcrest. David Dew and Linda Alt are responsible for this grant for Northwood.

This program supports advancement intended and outlined in Strategy XII, Middle School Initiative.
