Consent Agenda

A motion was made by John Peirce, seconded by Jordan Lebamoff that the following consent agenda items be approved: Minutes from the regular Board meeting held November 14, 2011; Vouchers for the period ending November 28, 2011 and personnel report. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none

Lease for Health and Wellness Center Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Lease for Health and Wellness Center:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board authorize the Superintendent to enter into a lease agreement for a new Health and Wellness Center.

RELATED INFORMATION: The district wishes to open two Health and Wellness Centers. One will be located on property owned by FWCS at 1517 Catalpa Street with anticipated opening of mid-February. We also recommend a second location be leased at 10012 Auburn Park Drive for an annual cost of \$29,750. The lease provides for a three-year term with an option to terminate early. Anticipated opening of this clinic is mid-January. Funding for the lease and improvements to both locations will be funded by the Health Insurance Fund.

Chief Financial Officer Kathy Friend and Chief Operations Officer Charles Cammack provided a brief overview of the changes to the FWCS health plan and recognized members of the committee who were in attendance.

A motion was made by John Peirce, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Lease for Health and Wellness Center be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Energy Leadership Contract Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Energy Leadership Contract:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve a five-year energy leadership contract with Performance Services, Inc. for \$205,000 per year. It is also recommended that FWCS hire two energy managers to support the program.

RELATED INFORMATION: Proposals were received from energy consultants for efficiency savings in our school district. The companies proposed saving energy by using behavioral changes and not capital equipment changes. This is a no-risk performance contract that guarantees that annual costs will be recovered due to energy savings. Energy managers monitor the program and educate employees. Performance Services recommendation had higher net savings to FWCS. A conservative net savings estimate is about \$590,000 per year after covering all costs.

Performance Services President Tim Thoman and Energy Leader Mike Lindsey answered questions and provided the Board with information about the program.

A motion was made by John Peirce, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Energy Leadership Contract be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Board Policy Approval

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Board Policy Approval:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board adopt revised Board Policies for sections 0000 Bylaws, 6000 Finances, 7000 Property, 8000 Operations and 9000 Relations.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Board Policy Committee is recommending revisions to Board Policies 0000, 6000, 7000, 8000 and 9000. The language has been shared with all Board members more than one day prior to this meeting.

Final copies of policies are on file in the Office of the Superintendent.

A motion was made by Becky Hill, seconded by John Peirce, that the recommendation concerning the Board Policy Approval be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Comments

Board members thanked the committee, Bill Sweet and Laura Cain for their diligence in revising the Board Policies.

Grading Practices/ Procedures in FWCS High Schools

Executive Director of Tobacco Free Allen County Dick Conklin thanked the Board for adopting an FWCS smoke free policy.

High School Area Administrator D. Faye Williams-Robbins provided Board members with an overview of recent efforts made to improve the accuracy/consistency of student assessment and grading practices within FWCS high schools. Board members asked questions and had conversations about grading practices. Ms. Robbins stated there will be a parent meeting for input on December 14.

Comments

Board member Julie Hollingsworth commented on an article in The Wall Street Journal about the need for technical tradesmen. These individuals don't need a 4-year college degree but a 2-year associate's degree or technical training. Ms Hollingsworth also encouraged students to take the most challenging classes in high school including Advanced Placement and dual credit courses. Ms. Hollingsworth also commented about on-line courses and the importance of the student / teacher relationship.

Board President Mark GiaQuinta asked Dr. Robinson to be sure that the FWCS administration keeps track of the meetings / hearings of the charter school board. Mr. GiaQuinta reminded Board members of the executive session on December 5, and the work session scheduled for December 19.

The next regular meeting of the Board is scheduled for Monday, December 12, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center.
