Tenafly High School Celebrates National Orchestra Acceptances

School achieves new goal as two students are accepted into prestigious National Association for Music Education program

Tenafly, NJ – October 29, 2021 –Tenafly High School celebrated a new first this month when senior Hannah Park and violist junior Angelina Lee were accepted to the National Association for Music Education (NAfME) All-National Honors Ensemble (ANHE). Each year, Tenafly High School students win a multitude of recognitions, but Park and Lee are the first to achieve All-National Orchestra.

“In my 18 years with Tenafly, we’ve never had anyone make All-National Orchestra,” said Director of Choirs and Orchestras Jim Millar. “I’m really proud of these guys.”

Park, a violinist, and Lee, a violist, achieved the All-National recognition following a series of auditions, earning a place in the North Jersey School Music Association (NJSMA) Region I Orchestra, and taking part in numerous rehearsals and auditions.

The 2021 virtual event will include several rehearsals with the 2021 ANHE Conductors and workshops with renown clinicians, and each ensemble will create a final, recorded performance which will be premiered online during the 37th-annual Music In Our Schools Month (MIOSM). Additional details will be shared in the coming weeks.

“For not only one but two of our students to achieve this honor is extraordinary,” said Tenafly High School principal Jim Morrison. “Hannah and Angelina have put in the work to make their talents shine and we are proud of their accomplishments. We know that they will continue to achieve great things.”
