This year, public schools in New Jersey return to the New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA) in English Language Arts/Literacy, Mathematics, and Science. Testing dates for Tenafly Public Schools middle school students are listed below.

Some portions of the NJSLA require students to listen to audio. If possible, please send your child to school with his or her own headphones as students' own headphones will be more comfortable. Headphones will be provided for any student who needs them. Please note that students are **not** allowed to bring bluetooth headphones.

**It is imperative that students arrive at school on time for all test administration days. Arriving late to school may result in your child having to make up a section of the assessment.**

Our Tenafly teachers prepare students for NJSLA assessments. Our curriculum is aligned with NJ Student Learning Standards and our students are regularly presented with the skills and knowledge essential for performing well on these tests. We believe



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that a strong curriculum, rather than isolated test prep, is the best way to prepare students for all types of assessments.
