- ❖ Review P.A.W.S. with your child.
- ❖ Ask your child about his/her day at school every day.
- ❖ Make sure your child is ready every day. Ensure a good night's sleep.
- ❖ Provide a quiet time and space for your child to do homework nightly.
- ❖ Keep in touch with your child's teacher.
- ❖ Encourage your child to use appropriate language and tone.
- ❖ Practice positive phrases with your child, such as, "Thank you," "Excuse me," "Please," and "I'm sorry."
- ❖ Be a visible part of your child's school day. Attend meetings and other school activities as your schedule allows.

### What is Positive

### Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS)?

PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) is a school wide approach to discipline and process for creating safer and more effective schools. PBIS is a systems approach to enhancing the capacity of schools to educate all children by developing school wide classroom discipline systems that are research-based. The process focuses on improving a school's ability to teach and support positive behavior for all students.

Instructional time is more effectively used for teaching and the overall school environment is calm and conducive to learning.
