Class Information

An emergency medical dispatcher is a professional telecommunicator, tasked with the gathering of information related to medical emergencies, the provision of assistance and instructions by voice, prior to the arrival of emergency medical services (EMS), and the dispatching and support of EMS resources responding to an emergency call. The term "emergency medical dispatcher" is also a certification level and a professional designation.

Included

- Up to 20 Hours of Dispatch Sit along hours outside the class
- 6 weeks Prep Course + 1 week Academy Course and Certification
- All fees include Books, Material, Certification costs.

Requirements

- Strong Interest in Emergency Services and Dispatch.
- **ID and Social Security Card** or Individual Tax ID Number must be provided at the time of registration. Name on **ID** and **Social Security Card** or Individual Tax ID Number **MUST match**.
- Must attend an orientation to complete enrollment.
- Clean background check, (A background Check disclosure form will be required)
- Take an EMD Candidate Aptitude Test prior to the Orientation.
