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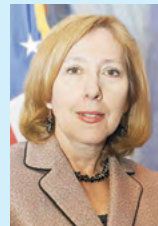
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Expanding Learning and Engaging Students!

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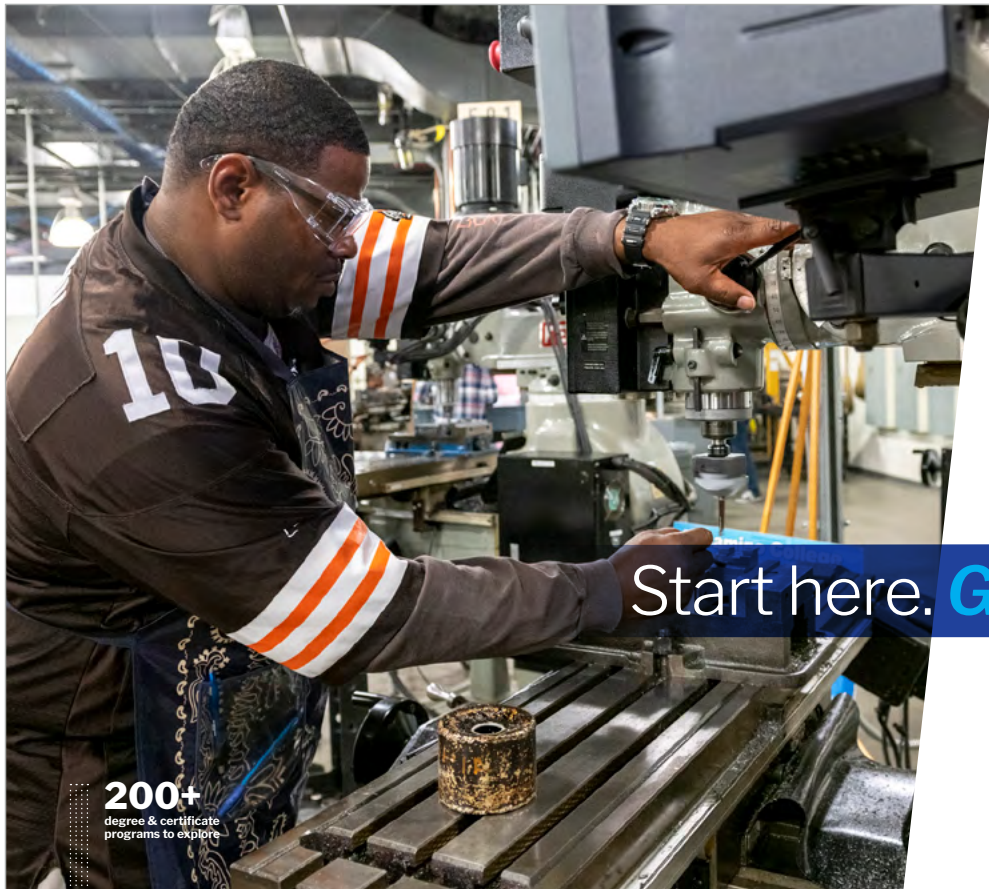

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Extended Learning Opportunities at Bud Carson Middle School

At BCMS, we believe that learning should not be confined to the four walls of a classroom. The afterschool program offers a variety of extended learning opportunities, that allows our students to explore their interests and develop new skills. Whether it's sports, arts, or STEM, we have something for everyone.

One of the most popular extended learning opportunities at Bud Carson is our sports program. We offer basketball, cheerleading, and soccer, giving our students a chance to stay active and learn the values of teamwork and sportsmanship.

For those interested in STEM, we have a Lego Club. Our students also learn about engineering and problem-solving while having fun with Legos.

For the more artistically inclined, we offer an art program. In addition, we have a gardening club that teaches our students about sustainability and the environment. Our students learn how to grow, compost, and care for plants while creating a beautiful and sustainable garden on campus.

We are especially proud of the chess club that teaches our students the game of chess and helps them improve their critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

Expanded learning opportunities provide a safe and structured environment for students to explore new interests, develop social skills and build relationships with peers. In this edition of *School News*, I will be highlighting the opportunities available to our students in the after school program at Eucalyptus. Led by site coordinator Tasha Melendez and 9 program leaders, we currently have 150 students enrolled in the program.

Every day, children participate in Homework and Tutoring, a Club Activity and Push Play PE (physical activity). Push Play PE provides videos which demonstrate rules of an outdoor game, followed by students and staff participating in the game. During the months of May and June, club activities will be offered in arts and crafts, gardening, chess, theater arts and Legos. The program begins after school with a snack, and ends at 6pm each night. 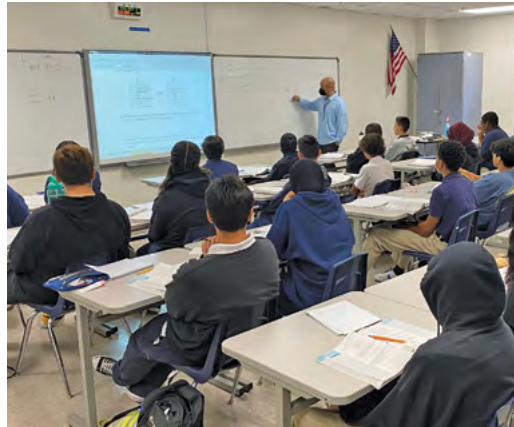

Mental Health in Children

Mental health issues like anxiety, depression, and self-harm among children have risen in recent years, and can have long-lasting effects on a child's physical, emotional, and social development.

Factors that can affect a child's mental health include genetics, environment, and life experiences. Common mental health disorders in children include anxiety disorders, depression, attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), and behavior disorders. These conditions can impact a child's ability to learn in school, interact with others, and develop healthy relationships.

Parents and teachers play a crucial role in promoting positive mental health among children. Some strategies for support include providing a safe and supportive environment, encouraging open communication, promoting healthy habits like exercise and good nutrition, and seeking help when needed.

Recognizing the warning signs of mental health issues in

children is important. These may include changes in behavior, mood, sleep, or appetite. Additionally, a child may express feelings of sadness, worry, or fear, have difficulty concentrating or completing tasks, or exhibit physical symptoms such as headaches or stomachaches. They may also isolate more than before.

It's important not to minimize their feelings. Children need to feel safe coming to parents with their issues, and as parents it's important to ask them how they feel if there is a change in behavior.

Early intervention and treatment can significantly improve a child's mental health outcome. Treatment options may include therapy, medication, lifestyle changes or a combination tailored to each child's needs. By supporting their mental health, we can help children develop into healthy, resilient adults.

Expanded Learning Opportunities

Prairie Vista has a variety of expanded learning opportunities for students. The Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P) provides funding for afterschool and summer school enrichment programs. “Expanded learning” means before school, after school, summer, or intersession learning programs that focus on developing the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests of pupils through hands-on, engaging learning experiences

Mr. Raymond Royero is our site leader for ELO-P, and the clubs that he oversees at PVMS are Flag Football, Soccer, Arts & Crafts, S.T.E.M, Volleyball, Gaming/ESPORTS, and Basketball. Our basketball team recently just played in a HUGE tournament against 5 different districts and they finished in 3rd place! They went 4 and 1. Their only loss came right before the championship game. We also have Yoga on Tuesdays and Thursdays as well as Chess on Wednesdays! Some strategies we use to help extend the learning are to help children see themselves as thinkers, teaching students to use rich vocabulary, physical development, personal, social and emotional development, literacy, mathematics, understanding the world, expressive arts and design, and have conversations about communication and language.

In addition to ELO-P, PVMS has dance, musical theatre, MESA, boys’ and girls’ soccer, and academic intervention after school.

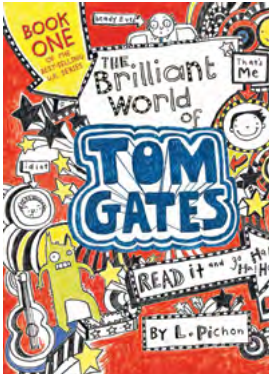

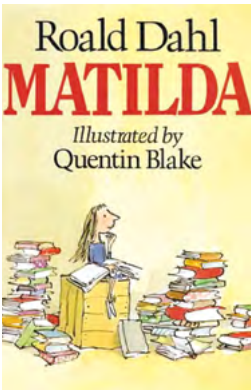
