How to Make an On-Line Lunch Payment

Dear Parents,

Our on-line payment system has been in place for some time now and we are happy to announce that it has been a very successful program. Providing parents with an on-line system to pay for your child(ren) lunch account(s) is easy. You may use your Visa, Master Card, Discover credit and/or debit card for this transaction. We are unable to take credit card payments at our buildings; this option is only available over the Internet. Our buildings and food service cashiers will still accept cash and checks.

Parents who use the on-line system must first create an account. You will need your child's ID number as part of the on-line registration. If you don't know your child's ID number, please contact your building secretary. No personal information about your student is available on-line. The district does not keep your credit card information on file and you will need to re-enter your credit card number each time you use the online system.

You can access the new on-line payment system by going to our district website (www.wlake.org), then click on the **SPS EZpay** logo to be transferred over to the payment site. Complete the registration page, and add your child's name(s) and ID number(s). Once you have registered and created a password you will not need the student ID number again. You can check your child's account balances as long as you have access to the Internet. You will receive a Low Lunch balance via e-mail. Please be sure to allow SPS EZpay into your email otherwise it will be considered spam and will go into your junk email.
