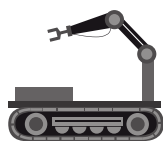

Seal Summary

Graduation in the state of Ohio states that students must earn at least two diploma seals, one of which must be a state defined seal. Counselors and graduation planning at each high school will ensure students maintain progress toward seal attainment by completing the necessary steps, forms, and evidence throughout their high school years.

State Seals



Biliteracy

This seal recognizes students who have high levels of proficiency in English and at least one other language. Proficiency attained on both an approved English test **and** an approved World Language assessment must be obtained.



Citizenship

This testing seal can be earned by satisfying one of the following: proficient score on History and Government OSTs, **or** proficient score on an AP/IB correlated test, **or** a grade of B or better in an approved CCP course.



College Ready

To earn this seal, a student must demonstrate readiness for college by successfully earning remediation-free scores on the ACT or SAT tests.



Honors

Any graduate who satisfies the requirements of an Honors Diploma designation earns this seal. There are six options for Honors Diplomas.



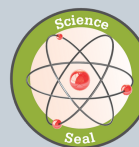
**Industry
Credential**

Credentials can take many forms. To earn this seal, students must do one of the following: earn a 12-point credential **or** earn a group of credentials totaling 12 points in a single field.



Military

To earn this seal, students provide evidence of enlistment with a signed DD Form 4 contract **or** participate in the high school's JROTC program for at least two years.



Science

This testing seal can be earned by satisfying one of the following: proficient score on Biology OST, **or** proficient score on an AP/IB correlated test, **or** earn a grade of B or better in an approved CCP course.



Technology

This testing or course seal can be earned by satisfying one of the following: proficient score on an AP/IB approved test, **or** a grade of B or better in a correlated CCP course, **or** successfully completing a district defined technology course.



**Ohio Means
Jobs**

This seal shows a graduate has demonstrated personal strengths, work ethics, and experience. To earn this seal, demonstrate 15 professional skills **and** have them validated by three mentors.

APS Local Seals



Community Service

To earn this seal, a student must complete 30 hours of high quality community service with an approved charitable organization **and** have those hours verified by the organization(s).



Fine and Performing Arts

To earn this seal, a student must participate in two units of Fine Arts eligible activities **and** have them verified by a program advisor or coach.



Student Engagement

To earn this seal, a student must participate in two approved units of curricular and/or extracurricular activities **and** have them verified by a program advisor, teacher, or coach.
