Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Parkview Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as a "HAS NOT BEEN GIVEN ONE OF THESE LABELS".

As a building, Novi Meadows achieves at a high level. However, data in the AER report indicates we still have some achievement gaps that need to be addressed. Data in the AER report indicates small gaps in the areas of reading, and math. These gaps exist between the general population and the following sub groups: African American, Economically Disadvantaged, English Language Learners and Student with Disabilities. In order to address these gaps in achievement, our building is implementing a number of initiatives. We have incorporated ELA and Math intervention services to help struggling learners master basic skills. These settings are used to pre-teach and reteach skills that are covered in the general education classroom. In addition, we have incorporated an A30/60 time into each student's day. This is a time where no new instruction takes place. Teachers are available to reteach at that time and work with selected groups of students on specific skills. Additionally, iObservation protocols are being used by classroom teachers to ensure that our students are receiving instruction in a best practice rich environment.

Process for Student Assignments

Upon registration, a resident must show proof of residency within the boundaries of the Novi Community School District. All 5th and 6th grade students in the Novi Community School District attend Novi Meadows.

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School Improvement Plan

The Novi Community School District participates in the Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process (MICIP) to improve student outcomes by assessing the needs of the whole child to develop plans and coordinate funding. This is year two of a five-year plan where Novi Meadows is striving to improve math instruction through ADD-Vantage Math Recovery (AVMR) and improving curriculum with the implementation of Understanding by Design.

School Description

Novi Meadows has about 1030 students. Approximately 54% of our students are Asian American, 34% are White, 7% are Black or African American, 4% are Hispanic or Latino, 1% are American Indian, 0.5% are Multi-Ethnic, and 0.5% are Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander. There are 27 home languages spoken by our students, and about 54% of our students are English Learners.

Core Curriculum

The Novi Community School District meets and exceeds the standards expectations adopted by the Michigan State Board of Education. The use of Atlas Rubicon Curriculum Maps system provides a common structure and easily accessible warehouse for intended curriculum as well as actual curriculum presented. i-Ready Results

The i-Ready diagnostic assessment is administered each fall, winter and spring to K-9 students across the district. This assessment provides a signpost indicator as to where a student is performing in comparison to grade level peers nationally in the areas of reading and math. The i-Ready system also provides Personalized Learning lessons for reading and math to students. These lessons follow an established learning path that is determined by student performance on the fall, winter and spring i-Ready assessments. Student performance on i-Ready lessons and assessments provide teachers and administrators with a means to contextually increase their knowledge of meaningful data use and its application to differentiated instruction for all students. Novi Meadows and the Novi Community School District also use i-Ready data results to compare and project student performance on statewide assessments. Student results are broken into 5 levels: 1 - Mid or Above Grade Level; 2 - Early On Grade Level; 3 - Onr Grade Level Below; 4 - Two Grade Levels Below; 5 - Three or More Grade Levels Below.
