



# STUDENT DRESS CODE

## IN GENERAL...

- SHIRTS NEED TO HAVE SLEEVES AND COLLAR AT THE NECK. NO TANK TOPS, STRAPS, OR CROP TOPS.
- JEANS, PANTS, SKIRTS, AND SHORTS ARE WORN AT THE WAIST.
- NO PAJAMAS, RIPPED, TORN, SHEER, OR NEEDED CLOTHING.
- UNDERGARMENTS SHOULD NOT BE SEEN (NO SAGGING).
- ONLY CLOSED TOE SHOES ARE ALLOWED (CROCS ARE OK). NO FLIP FLOPS, SLIDES, OR SLIPPERS.
- HATS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON CAMPUS. HOODS AND SUNGLASSES ARE DOWN OR OFF OF STUDENT'S HEAD WHEN INSIDE THE BUILDING.
- NO PROFESSIONAL SPORTS TEAMS, PROFANITIES OR OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE, DRUGS (INCLUDING "COOKIES"), VIOLENCE, OR SEXUAL REFERENCES





# HARRISON STUDENT DRESS CODE

ALBUQUERQUE PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND HARRISON MIDDLE SCHOOL HAVE A SHARED GENERAL PHILOSOPHY REGARDING APPROPRIATE DRESS AND HYGIENE FOR SCHOOL. WE SHARE AN EXPECTATION THAT STUDENTS AND STAFF WILL DRESS IN A PROFESSIONAL AND APPROPRIATE MANNER FOR THE BUSINESS OF EDUCATION. WE ARE TO DRESS IN A WAY THAT DOES NOT DISRUPT, DISTRACT, OR INTERRUPT THE EDUCATIONAL PROCESS. THE HARRISON ADMINISTRATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INTERPRET AND MODIFY THE DRESS POLICY AT ANY TIME. ALL ADMINISTRATIVE DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

STUDENTS AND THEIR PARENTS/GUARDIANS ARE:

- RESPONSIBLE TO BE AWARE OF THE DRESS CODE.
- RESPONSIBLE TO ADHERE TO THE REQUIREMENTS.
- RESPONSIBLE TO BE IN STANDARD DRESS AT ALL TIMES WHEN ON CAMPUS.

IN GENERAL, CLOTHING/ACCESSORIES MAY NOT:

- PROMOTE PROFANITY, OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE, OR DISCRIMINATORY LANGUAGE.
- HAVE PROFESSIONAL SPORTS TEAMS LOGOS. COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES ARE ACCEPTABLE.
- HAVE ALCOHOL, DRUGS/DRUG USE (INCLUDING "COOKIES"), VIOLENCE/WEAPONS, IMAGES OF NUDITY, OR SEXUAL REFERENCES.
- HAVE GANG-ASSOCIATED SYMBOLS, BANDANAS, OR BANDANA TYPE CLOTHING.

ARTICLES OF CLOTHING AND ACCESSORIES THAT PROMOTE OR ADVERTISE SUBJECT MATTER INAPPROPRIATE TO A LEARNING ENVIRONMENT ARE NOT ALLOWED. THIS INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING: "I LOVE BOOBIES", "I LOVE HATERS", "FXXX", ETC. THE ADMINISTRATION HAS THE RIGHT TO DISCIPLINE STUDENTS WITH ANY OFFENSIVE ARTICLES OF CLOTHING OR ACCESSORIES.

HEAD

- HOODIES AND BEANIES MAY BE WORN OUTSIDE. HOODS SHOULD BE DOWN INSIDE A BUILDING.
- HATS/CAPS/HEAD COVERINGS ARE NOT ALLOWED UNLESS THERE ARE SPECIFIC AND DOCUMENTED INSTRUCTIONAL SAFETY, CULTURAL, RELIGIOUS, OR MEDICAL REASONS FOR THE STUDENT.
- SUNGLASSES MAY ONLY BE WORN OUTSIDE. WHEN NOT OUTSIDE SUNGLASSES NEED TO BE REMOVED FROM THE HEAD/FACE.

SHIRTS

- POLO SHIRTS, T-SHIRTS, AND OTHER SHIRTS WITH SLEEVES AND COLLAR AT THE NECK ARE REQUIRED (NO STRAPS, TANK TOPS, MUSCLE SHIRTS, ETC.). SKIN SHOULD NOT BE SHOWN BETWEEN THE BOTTOM OF SHIRT AND TOP OF PANTS. UNDERGARMENTS SHOULD NOT BE VISIBLE AT ANY TIME.
- NO PAJAMAS, RIPPED, TORN, SHEER, OR NEEDED CLOTHING.

PANTS, SKIRTS, SHORTS, AND DRESSES (BOYS AND GIRLS)

- UNDERGARMENTS (BOXERS, SHORTS, UNDERWEAR) MUST NOT BE VISIBLE.
- SKIRTS, DRESSES, AND SHORTS LENGTH SHOULD BE LONGER THAN STUDENTS FINGERTIPS WHEN ARMS ARE DOWN.
- NO PAJAMAS, RIPPED, TORN, SHEER, OR NEEDED CLOTHING.

SHOES

- SHOES AND SOCKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES (CROCS WITH SOCKS ARE ACCEPTABLE).
- TENNIS/ATHLETIC SHOES ARE REQUIRED FOR PE AND ATHLETIC CLASSES.
- NO PAJAMA SLIPPERS, SLIDES, FLIP FLOPS, ROLLER SKATES, ROLLER BLADES OR HEELYS ALLOWED.

OTHER

- NO BLANKETS

DRESS CODE VIOLATION(S) PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE (UNLESS VIOLATION IS EGREGIOUS):

STEP 1: PARENTS NOTIFIED THAT STUDENT IS OUT OF DRESS CODE. WARNING GIVEN.

STEP 2: PARENTS NOTIFIED THAT STUDENT IS OUT OF DRESS CODE. 1 DAY LUNCH DETENTION

STEP 3: PARENTS CALLED TO BRING IN PROPER CLOTHING. 1 DAY LUNCH DETENTION.

STEP 4: ADMINISTRATIVE CONFERENCE WITH PARENTS AND STUDENT TO COMMUNICATE DRESS EXPECTATIONS AND NEXT PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE STEPS.
