

LIBERTY TRADITIONAL SCHOOL- STUDENT SAFETY TAGS



Parents and Guardians,

Student Safety Tags are a safety protocol that we use at Liberty Traditional to help us ensure student safety. There are continued concerns regarding student pick-up and transportation needs, and we believe it is in the best interest of our children to be proactive in protecting them as they leave campus each day.

EVERY STUDENT is required to have transportation tag(s) attached to their backpack indicating their mode of transportation from school.

STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE CAMPUS WITHOUT THE APPROPRIATE TAG. PARENTS/GUARIDIANS WILL NEED TO PICK UP IN THE FRONT OFFICE IF THE APPROPRIATE SAFETY TAG IS NOT ON THE BACKPACK.

SAFETY TAG PROCEDURES:

- LTS teachers and staff will NOT allow a student to leave campus if they do not have their safety tag attached to their backpack.
- Additional/replacement tags are \$2 each.

Bus students: All students who ride the bus will receive a BUS tag with their name and bus color on the tag. This allows teachers and bus drivers to correctly identify the student and match them to the appropriate bus.

Walk/Bike: All students who walk or ride a bike at the end of the day will receive a WALK/RIDE tag with their name on it. This will help staff correctly identify those students who have parent permission to leave campus by walking or riding a bike.

Parent/Guardian pick-up: All students who are picked up by a parent or guardian after school will receive a tag with their name and # on the tag. Students will then listen for their pick up # and walk to the appropriate pick location when their number is called.

- ♦ **Parent Tags:** ALL families will receive TWO parent tags that match the # on their child's safety tag.
- ♦ ALL students in the same family will receive the same family # for pick up.

Reminders regarding transportation changes and end of the day dismissal:

- **We do not release students during the last 30 minutes of the day.**
- **We cannot make transportation changes over the phone, so please be sure to write a note in the Agenda if you need to make changes to your child's schedule.**

When to pick up your tags:

If you want to avoid the safety tag line on Back-2-School night, feel free to pick up your tags the week of August 1st, between 9:00AM and 2:00 PM.

(FYI- the line gets long at Back-2-School Night, so you'll want to plan accordingly!)
