#### School Starts Monday, August 21, 2022

School hours are from 9:00 a.m. - 4:10 p.m. It is imperative that students arrive at school on time every day. Please note, supervision for students is <u>not</u> available until 8:45 a.m. Car riders will be directed to begin exiting at 8:45 a.m. Walkers may not loiter on school property prior to the start of school and must enter the main entrance with car riders.

#### Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

#### 8:45 AM: Car Arrival - Students will begin the dismissal process from cars/vans.

When students arrive at school in the morning they must remain in their vehicle until individual cars are directed for release by our security officer or a supervisor. Students will enter the main doors and go straight to the cafeteria to breakfast. Students not eating breakfast will go straight to their assigned homeroom classroom. Students are not allowed to visit other classrooms or wander in the hallways. Students are not allowed to go back downstairs, so please talk to your child about making sure they eat first.

Early Dismissal: Ends at 3:30 p.m. Due to the close of day operating procedures we cannot extend these times.

4:10 PM: Dismissal – Students riding buses will be escorted to their bus by their classroom teacher. Students that are car riders, daycare van riders and walkers will exit the front doors at approximately 4:10 PM on Country Club Drive. Parents are to remain in their vehicles for safety reasons. Parents picking up their car-rider must access the single curb side car line for safe pickup. Staff will assist students to their car or van. For safety reasons we ask that parents pull to the farthest end of the line along the school curb, and always remain in their vehicle.

It is imperative that students are picked up from school no later than 4:10 PM. Any student that is not picked up on time will need to be signed out at the office.

#### Free Breakfast Program

Breakfast is from 8:45 a.m.-9:00 a.m. each morning. Children are to arrive on time to eat and be in class by 9:00 a.m.

#### **School Uniforms**

School uniforms are required, and must be worn daily. Last year's Normandy Uniforms are acceptable as well but will not be issued (Green Polo with Normandy Emblem and Khaki slacks or skirt).

Top: Polo type shirt: Navy Blue, Powder Blue, or White.

**Bottom:** Khaki slacks or skirt. Students may not wear jeans, cut off shorts or items that cover the uniform while in the building. Please plan accordingly—students may wear a thin long sleeve shirt under their uniform shirt. Jackets, coats, sweaters, or hoodies may not be worn in the building.

**Items Not Allowed:** Bonnets, Scarfs, Wave Caps, Hats/Caps, Bandanas, Hoodies, Crocs, Slides, Open Toe/Heel Shoes. NOTE: Winter hats/earmuffs are allowed during cold weather but must be removed once in the building.
