A Recap of the Topic of Study

Requirement 1

- Meaningful college and career readiness MSDE is studying what is the career or college measurement
- What measure of readiness is more important than a test score, a GPA or a combination of both

Requirement 2

• Provide intensive intervention services to students who are not on track to becoming College and Career readiness

Requirement 3

• Post graduation pathway – AP/IB, Dual enrollment for Associates Degree; Career and Technical Education; Support Pathway for those not ready for College and Career

Requirement 4

- Middle and High school students access career counseling program based on their ability
- 45% of high school students earn an industry recognized credential in their trade of choice

• Form an external CTE committee to help steer students into fields of need – make them ready with certifications
