Appendix A: CCSD Student Dress Code

The purpose of a dress code is to promote an orderly learning environment in our schools while preparing all students for later success in the workplace. The District's Student Dress Code guidance was developed through the direction of the Superintendent and with the cooperation of parents, students, teachers and administrators.

CCSD students are expected to dress in a manner that is conducive to a good learning environment. The administration reserves the right to prohibit accessories/clothing if those items create a potential safety or injury risk to the individual student or others; or, if the school administration determines a reasonable disruption to the classroom or school environment exists.

CCSD schools will strive to enforce the dress code consistently and in a manner that does not reinforce or increase marginalization or oppression of any student or group (e.g., race, gender, body type/size, etc.). School Administrators, in collaboration with staff, students and parents will annually create basic norms and expectations for student dress. The District recognizes that dress code norms may vary among school levels (ES/MS/HS).
