### Position Overview and Responsibilities

The technical director will collaborate with the theater directors to provide technical theater guidance and supervision to students grades 6 through 12. This is a part-time, stipend position.

- Supervise and mentor Middle School and High School technical students.
- Engage in daily rehearsals for a four show season. Middle School and High School groups rehearse from 3 to 5 pm after school. The High School group rehearses on some weekends from 9 to 5 pm.
- Maintain the theater workshop and lighting inventory.
