	2 clear rolls of tape* (preferably on the little plastic tape dispenser) 1 at a time in pencil box	
	4 highlighters (yellow)* 1 at a time in pencil box	
	2 glue sticks* 1 at a time in pencil box	
	1 package of white erasers* 1 eraser at a time in pencil box	
	8 Dry Erase Markers (black) * 2 at a time in pencil box	
	1 pencil box big enough to fit all the supplies with a *star* (Please buy a nice quality pencil box so it will last throughout the year.)	
	2 spiral, wide-ruled notebooks (any color/design)	
	1 Mead Primary Journal, Half Page Ruled, K-2nd Grade	
	1 STANDARD size backpack (NO WHEELS or SMALL backpacks please)	

Please Note:

We ask families to also have a container at home that includes: a **CALCULATOR** (as we will not be able to send one home), scissors, colored pencils, pencils, paper, etc. It is often necessary for students to use these items on homework. Transporting supplies back and forth from school isn't an option.
