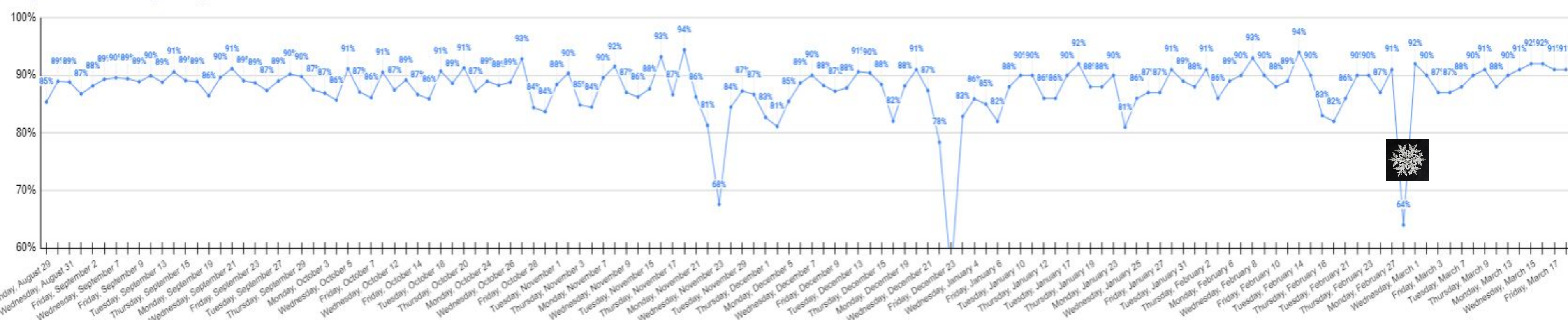

High School ADA - **87.49%**(March 2022)

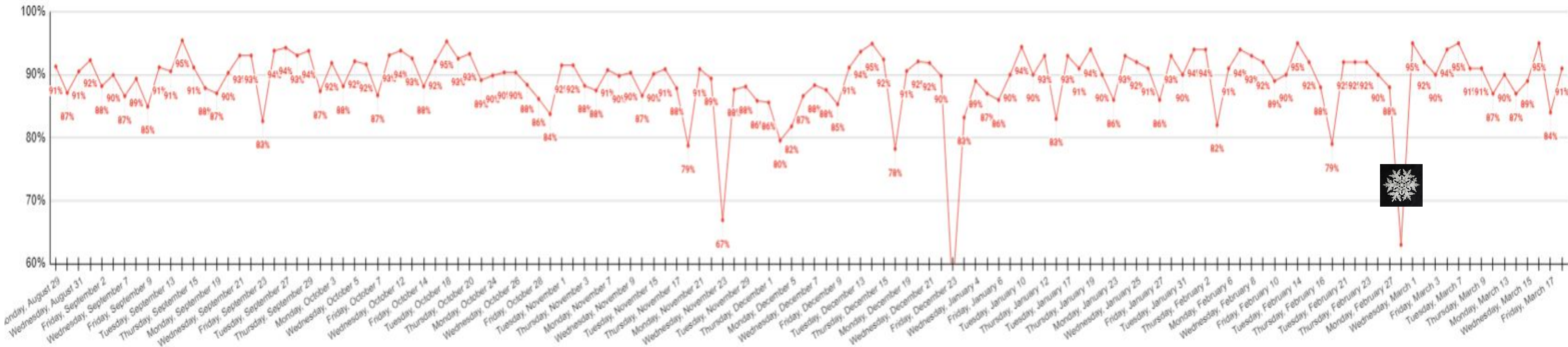

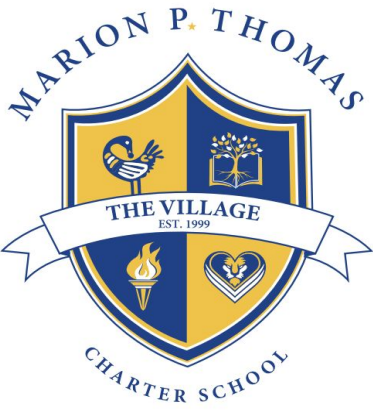

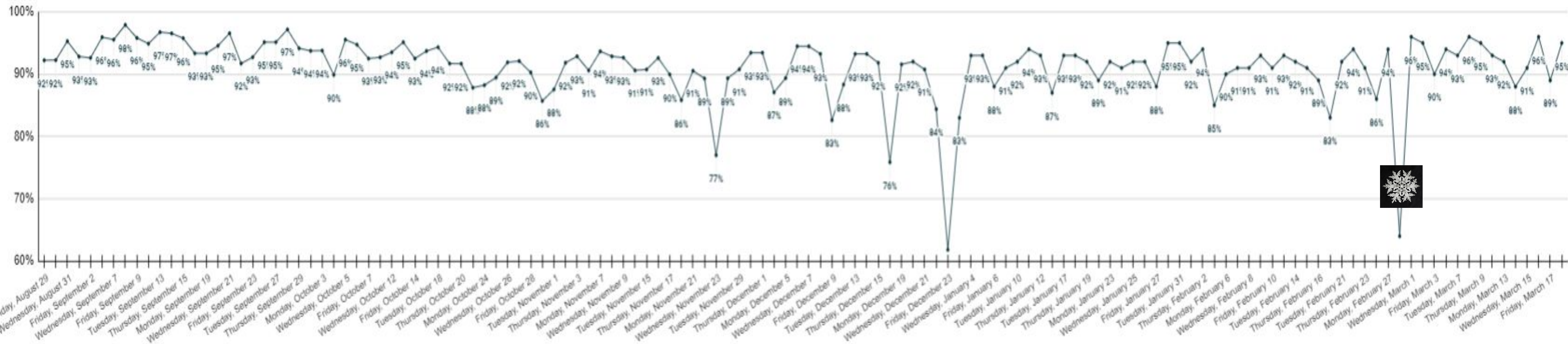

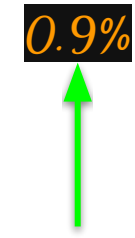

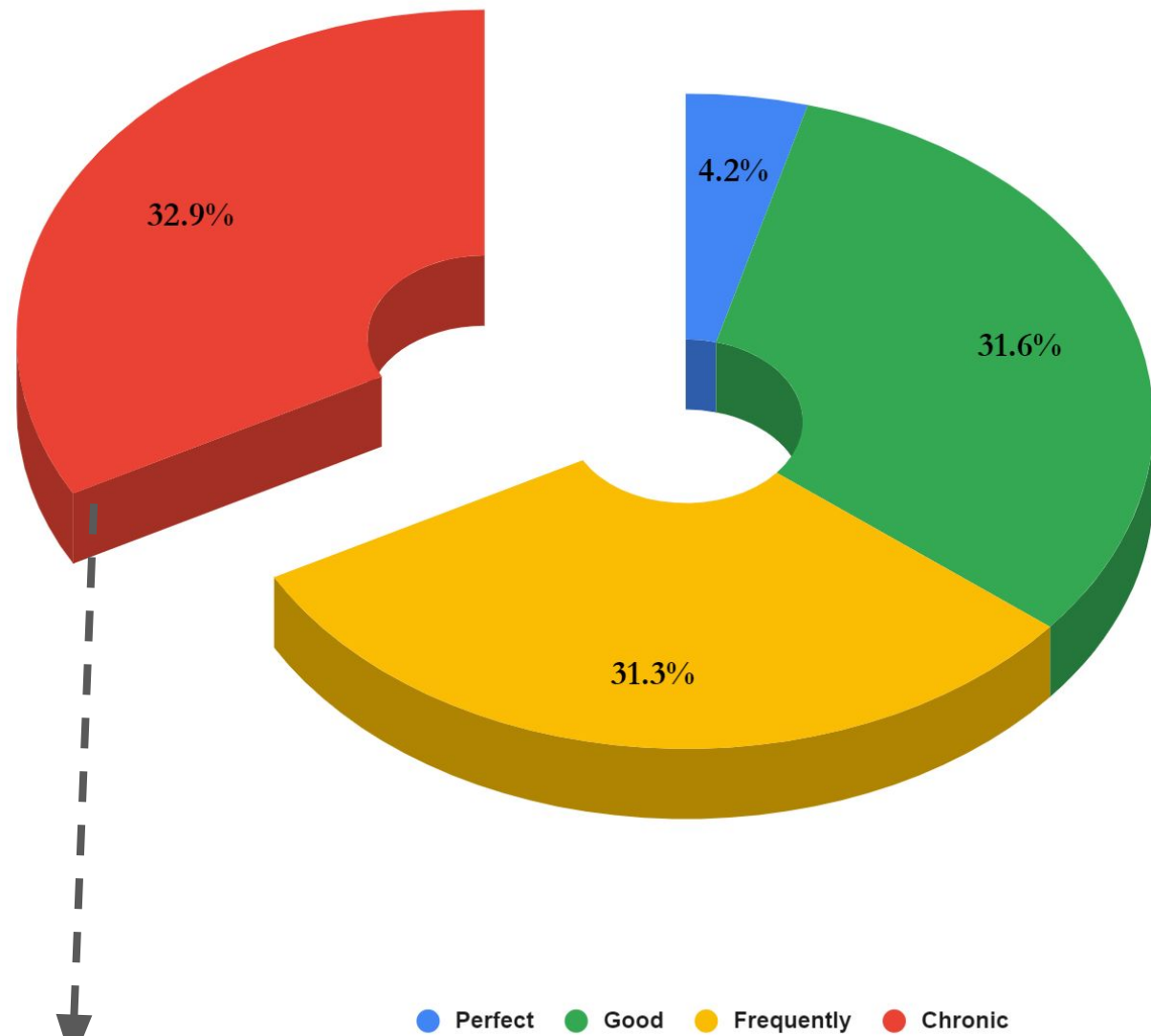

District Totals:

- Chronic Absenteeism Rates
 - **22-23 SY = 32.9%**
 - 21-22 SY = 49.5% (6/30/22)
 - 20-21 SY = 72.4% (6/30/21)
- Average Daily Attendance (ADA)
 - **22-23 SY = 90.44% (current)**
 - 21-22 SY = 87.10%
 - 20-21 SY = 81.06%

MARCH 2022 was 48.2%.

We have reduced the number to 32.9%

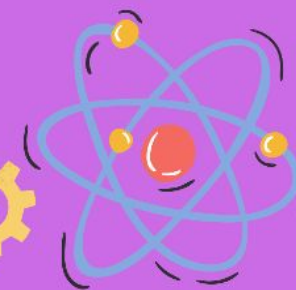

TOPOGRAPHICAL MAP PROJECT





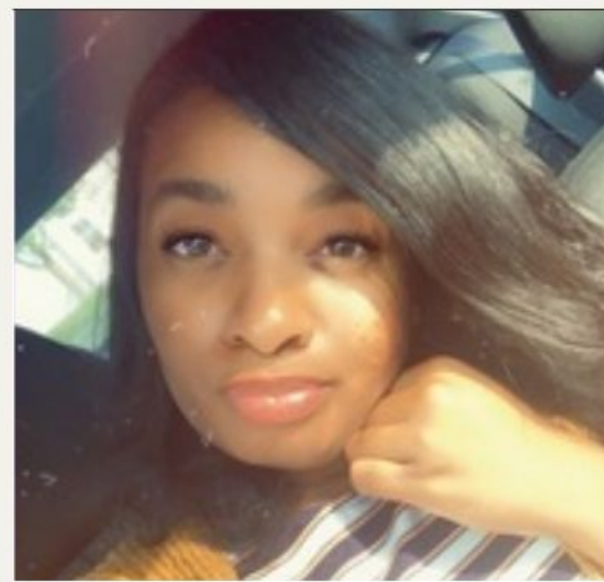
