


High School - Strategic Goal = 93%

ADA Year-to-Date: 89.46% 1.97%


High School ADA - 87.49% (March 2022)






PAC - Strategic Goal = 93%

PAC ACADEMY - Average Daily Attendance













STEAM ACADEMY - Average Daily Attendance





Chronic Absenteeism - District Percentages (As of 3/21/23)




MARCH 2022 was 48.2%.


We have reduced the number to 32.9%

 - o 20-21 SY = 81.06%



Shirley hows a love of learning and a desire to explore and understand the world around her. She has a natural curiosity and ask many questions and shows a willingness to try new things and take on challenges.








CORE VALUES EXEMPLIFIED THE TORCH
