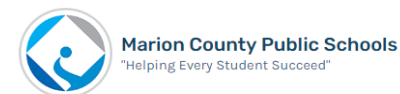
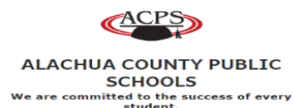
### Services:

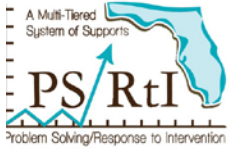
