THE PROGRAMME

WHAT TO EXPECT

- **1. Performance Programme:** For those in players (boys and girls) who compete at county level or above. This programme offers the opportunity for players to train within timetable with our specialist coaches, to access skill set clubs and performance squad sessions across all 3 terms. We then have a challenging summer term fixture list. The school has a "county+ release policy" which enables player to play in any county fixture during term time if academic clearance is granted and there is not a clash with a National Cup fixture. Players will also receive strength and conditioning and physio support from the Millfield Institute of Sport and Wellbeing team.
- 2. Participation Programme: This programme offers any pupil the opportunity to access hard ball cricket in the Spring Term (weekly session) and summer term (Games and fixture programme). Additional soft ball cricket opportunities are run across all 3 academic terms within the Year 9 Programme and our Millfield Activities Programme (MAP).
- **3. Summer sport only model.** We run 16 squads who compete in hard ball against a combination of our local cricket playing schools, local clubs, counties, regional academies, universities, and overseas touring teams. We also offer internal competition in both hard ball and softball cricket across both the boys and girls programme to cater for every pupils specific cricketing needs.
- **4. Private Coaching:** We have 4 highly qualified ECB coaches who are available to add additional practice and advice to our players.

WHO CAN DO IT

We provide opportunities for all pupils from October to July in each academic year. One of the coaching highlights is to work with those with little or no prior cricketing experience and to help ignite their passion for the game.
