Intermediate Acting, I

This class is designed for the child who has participated in an Introduction to Acting class and was recommended to continue to the Intermediate Acting class or has equivalent experience on stage. Students will be encouraged to expand their performance skills to create characters with depth and motivation, work through scene work, and use their basic knowledge of theatre vocabulary to interpret the essentials of a scene. Each student will leave the class with new skills and ready to take on their next performance!

Intermediate Acting, II

Ages 12 to 17

Saturdays 11:00- 12:00 p.m.

Tuition: \$180.00

This class is designed for the child who has participated in Intermediate Acting I, and was recommended to continue in Intermediate Acting, II. Students will be encouraged to expand on their performance skills by going more in depth with character analysis and motivations, continuing ensemble to put on a One, Act play. Each student will leave the class with new skills and ready to take on their next performance!

***Student must be recommended or get approval to participate in this class from Intermediate I.**



Jumpstart Music

Ages 3 to 5
