READ TOGETHER

- Share the book. You read a page, I read a page.
- Talk about the story, characters or facts.
- Talk about the pictures.
- Give compliments on what your child can do, tries to do, and their effort.

LISTEN TO READING

- Select a book online.
 - For help with our online programs, contact your child's teacher.
- After listening, share your thinking.







EMPOWER YOUR CHILD TO READ ON THEIR OWN

- Encourage your child to read a chapter or a quick read book on their own! Let them choose their own book (comic book, chapter book, poem, etc.)
- Remind then to take time to look at the pictures.
- Ask them to find the part or the picture they like most and share it with you.

TALK ABOUT READING

- Asking questions is a great way to get the conversation going about reading.
 - What was the problem in the story?
 - What lesson did the main character learn?
 - What did you find most interesting about this book?
 - Would you recommend this book to your friends?Why or why not?
 - What wonderings do you have?
