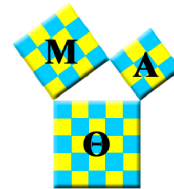

Continued Membership Requirements

Membership is on a year-to-year basis. As such, all members must:

1. **Members:** maintain an overall weighted MHS GPA of a 90% or higher (unrounded) and maintain unweighted Math average across all math courses of 88% or higher (unrounded).
2. Show active participation in a **minimum of 2** mathematical activities, such as: Math League, Pi Day, tutoring, Sir Isaac Newton Day, etc.
3. Members need to attend all NMHS meetings and inductions.
4. Members need to participate in the Annual American Mathematics Competition (AMC) and either the AMTNJ Contest or the Trig Star Contest.

5. Character Criteria

These are some examples, not a checklist of criteria, but not limited to:

The candidate of character:

- upholds scholarship and shows loyalty to the school
- demonstrates the highest standards of honesty and reliability
- complies with school rules
- takes criticism willingly and accepts recommendations graciously
- exemplifies desirable qualities of personality (cheerfulness, friendliness, poise)
- upholds principles of morality and ethics
- shows concern and respect for others
- observes instructions and rules both inside and outside the classroom
- perseveres in all commitments

Students' disciplinary records will be reviewed from the time period of 9th grade through the current grade of application. Students must be in good disciplinary standing for consideration for entry to Mu Alpha Theta.

As a reminder, all incidents involving academic integrity are reported to the principal and recorded as part of a student's disciplinary record. The student may be removed or barred from holding or being a candidate for any leadership position where character, honesty, or integrity are stated or implied qualifications, including athletic teams and clubs. Additionally, the student may be denied or lose membership in the National Honor Society, subject-area honor society, student council, and as a peer leader. Any further incidences involving academic integrity will be referred to the principal for additional disciplinary measures. (as per student handbook pg. 28).
