

Meeker Middle School's new dress code to be implemented in 2023-24 promotes a positive, inclusive, safe environment that helps students focus without distraction on learning. The dress code below honors school spirit, student comfort, individual expression, and busy family life. The code was developed with student, staff, and parent input. Students who are out of compliance with this code will be asked to remedy the situation to meet the following expectations:

ITEMS	Description
TOPS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meeker Spirit wear encouraged and rewarded with Meeker Money • Shirt to always meet the belt line • Shirt sleeves a minimum of 3 fingers wide • Undergarments may not be visible
BOTTOMS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear comfortable clothes that allow you to move • Rips, holes, tears must be below mid-thigh • Skirts, dresses & shorts must be longer than mid-thigh • Undergarments may not be visible
FOOTWEAR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Footwear should be appropriate for all school activities and always worn • Must be closed-toed with backs or heel straps. This means no slides are allowed, however, Crocs in "sport mode" are okay with the following exception: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Crocs and open-toed shoes are NOT allowed for science labs and PE (Physical Education) activities due to safety. • Heels no taller than 2 inches • NO flip-flops, sports sandals/slides, slippers, or shoes with wheels
ACCESSORIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be safe, non-suggestive and non-disruptive to the learning environment • For safety reasons it is important that students are identifiable. Therefore, keep hoods down and hats off inside the building • Scarves, gloves, and sunglasses must be kept in locker • Keep capes, stuffed animals, and blankets at home
NOTES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clothing messages & images must comply with all TPS district policies • Policy 3240R states: "Items with hate speech, hate group association, threats, pornographic content, or promotion of illegal or violent conduct (weapons, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or drug paraphernalia)" are not allowed
