## **Safe, Engaged Students Achieving at High Levels**

If we establish high expectations for everyone in the organization; provide high levels of support to one another with respect and grace; and accept personal accountability to one another and to our community; then we will improve student outcomes and the PGSD community.

### Domain 1 – Student Achievement

Theory of Action:

If we...

- Program a rigorous curriculum aligned to PA Core Standards;
- Engage teachers in a feedback/reflection cycle of inquiry;
- Employ data to inform instructional decisions; and
- Identify and provide instructional support for all students

Then we will...

- Improve instructional practice;
- Improve student achievement for all students; and
- Improve the value to our community.

**Goal 1.1** - Increase the percentage of student achievement metrics categorized as *Above* and *Well Above* from the 2024 Spring PSSA/Keystone Exam data file compared to the 2023 levels.

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if the percentage of multiple metrics (Student Achievement, Growth, and Comparison Group metrics) categorized as [Above](#) or [Well Above](#) from the 2024 Spring PSSA/Keystone Exam datafile exceeds 2023 levels.
- **Reporting**
  - 2023 PSSA/Keystone Exam data will be presented to the Curriculum, Instruction, and Technology committee at the September 2023 meeting or as they become available.
  - 2024 PSSA/Keystone Exam data will be presented to the Curriculum, Instruction, and Technology committee at the September 2024 meeting or as they become available.

### District Action Plans:

- Implement instructional coaching model K-12
- Implement MTSS in Grades K-12
- Implement new curricular materials in Mathematics K-12
- Curricular development of Text Dependent Analysis (TDA) in Grades K-8
- Continue implementation of Exact Path best practices Grades 1-8

Theory of Action:

If we...

- Improve metrics for supporting and measuring student outcomes;
- Develop programs to meet the needs of all students; and
- Augment existing community service projects

Then we will...

- Improve students' college and career readiness;
- Provide students with a competitive advantage for post-secondary success;
- Affirm the value of student service to students and the community; and
- Strengthen the connection with our community.

**Goal 2.1** Measurably improve communication and collaboration with shareholder groups (staff, parents, students, and community members).

- **Performance Metrics** – The goal will be considered met if there is an increase in the number of opportunities for stakeholders to meaningfully engage.
- **Reporting** - Progress will be reported to Athletics, Co-curricular, & Community Relations Committee (ACCR)
  - Beginning-of-Year plan presented (September 19, 2023 ACCR)
  - End-of-Year data presented to Board (June 11, 2024 ACCR)

**Goal 2.2** Measurably improve college and career readiness of PGHS students.

- **Performance Metrics** - the goal will be considered met if there is successful implementation of a career speaker series; exploration of college fair; exploration of career fair; and at least 95% completion of College & Career Measures.
- **Reporting** - Progress will be reported to the CIT committee
  - Mid-Year update - January 16, 2024
  - End-of-Year report - May 21, 2024

**Goal 2.3** Strengthen student engagement by increasing the number of students participating in a school sponsored activity.

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if we increase the number of unique students participating in at least one activity (sport or club)
- **Reporting** - Progress will be reported to the Athletics, Co-curricular, and Community Relations Committee
  - Fall 2023 Update - November 14, 2023
  - Winter 2024 Update - January 16, 2024
  - Spring 2024 Update - March 26, 2024
  - End-of-Year Update - June 11, 2024

**Goal 2.4** Pilot a peer mentoring program of High School leaders paired with elementary students at Ringing Rocks.

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met by successful implementation of peer mentoring program
- **Reporting** - Presentation by High School Mentors - March 12, 2024 Board Meeting

### Domain 3 – Safety & Advocacy

Theory of Action:

If we...

- Continue to enhance school safety and security;
- Strengthen partnerships with local first responders; and
- Support the physical, emotional, and academic needs of all students.

Then we will...

- Ensure the safety of staff and students;
- Improve student outcomes.

**Goal 3.1** Ensure all buildings are in 100% compliance with updated safety measures. Identify and implement high-impact safety and security modifications.

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if all district safety measures, protocols, and procedures are updated and all buildings are in full compliance (50%); and if high-impact safety and security modifications are successfully implemented (50%), e.g. migrate safety plans to digital application, implement CSTAG.
- **Reporting** - Progress will be reported to the Operations/Facilities Committee
  - Mid-year update, January 9, 2024
  - End-of-year update, May 14, 2024

**Goal 3.2** Continue implementation of Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) in grades K-8 including SEL and PBIS. Design and begin implementation of MTSS in grades 9-12 including integration of SEL and PBIS programming.

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if by the end of 2023-24, PGSD has fully implemented MTSS in grades K-8 (75%) and has begun MTSS implementation in grades 9-12 (25%).
- **Reporting** - quarterly at CIT Committee meetings.

- Ensure programs meet organizational needs

**Goal 4.1** Redesign and implement Falcon Academy at Middle School and High School

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be met by successful implementation of redesigned alternate education programming at PGMS and PGHS
- **Reporting** - Updates will be provided at Curriculum, Integration, and Technology Committee meetings as needed including:
  - Fall Update - September 19, 2023
  - Spring Update - May 21, 2024

**Goal 4.2** Implement Pre-K Counts

- Performance Metrics - The goal will be met by successfully implementing 2 Pre-K Counts classrooms at Lower Pottsgrove Elementary
- Reporting - Updates will be provided at Curriculum, Integration, and Technology Committee meetings as needed including:
  - Fall Update - September 19, 2023
  - Spring Update - May 21, 2024

**Goal 4.3** Implement Chromebooks at Middle School and develop High School transition plan

- Performance Metrics
- Reporting - Updates will be provided at Curriculum, Integration, and Technology Committee meetings as needed including:
  - Fall Update - September 19, 2023
  - Spring Update - May 21, 2024

**Goal 4.4** Develop common assessments in eDoctrina

- **Performance Metrics** -The goal will be considered met if common assessments are developed in all curriculum areas participating in the pilot group.
- **Reporting** - Quarterly

**Goal 4.5** Implement Before/After Care

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if Before/After Care is implemented at each of the 3 elementary buildings
- **Reporting** - August 22, 2023 Board Meeting

**Goal 4.6** Implement streamlined Teacher Evaluation

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if the Teacher Evaluation system is streamlined to implement an instructional coaching model
- **Reporting** - June 2023

**Goal 4.7** Redesign Code of Conduct K-12

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if PGSD has implemented K-12 Code of Conduct for the 2023-24 school year.
- **Reporting** - Periodically and June 2023

**Goal 4.8** Launch redesigned website

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if PGSD has launched a redesigned website.
- **Reporting** - August 22, Board Meeting

## Domain 5 - Financial Management

Theory of Action:

If we...

- Manage fiscal and physical resources responsibility, efficiently, and effectively

Then we will...

- Ensure that District funds are optimally invested.

**Goal 5.1** Manage 2023-24 expenditures within budget.

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if 2023-24 expenditures are less than 2023-24 budgeted expenditures.
- **Reporting** - Periodically and June 2024

**Goal 5.2** Redesign Pottsgrove Virtual Academy programming and re-enroll Pottsgrove students enrolled in out-of-district cyber charter schools.

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if 2023-24 out-of-district cyber charter enrollments are 10% lower than 2022-23.
- **Reporting** - Periodically and June 2024

**Goal 5.3** Develop and present a 5-year projection of enrollment and financial well-being for the District.

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be considered met if the District prepares a 5-year projection that includes projected enrollments based upon live birth data and housing start assumptions, capital projects, and other relevant financial components.
- **Reporting** - Quarterly

**Goal 5.4** Develop 10-year Capital Plan

- **Performance Metrics** - The goal will be met with the presentation of completed 10-year Capital Plan and monthly updates.
- **Reporting** - Not later than November 9, 2023 Operations/Facilities Committee and thereafter monthly updates at Facilities and Operations Committee.
