

UNIFORMS

Girls:

- Tops: Polo shirt: Red, White, Black
- Bottoms: Khaki skirt, pants, or shorts; plaid jumper or skirt

Boys:

- Tops: Polo shirt: Red, White, or Black
- Bottoms: Khaki pants or shorts

Accessories:

- Belt (Optional): Brown or Black Leather
- Leggings (Optional): White, Black or Red

PE/Athletics:

- Athletic uniforms are distributed by the Athletics Department.

Shoes:



- Students leaving school early, must sign out in the office with parent permission (note, phone call, email).




DISCIPLINE

Chromebooks will be issued to 10th - 12th Graders on the first day of school. 9th Graders will receive their Chromebooks at 9th Grade Orientation.






