

SHS Booster Meeting Minutes **9/13/17**

7:03 Meeting was called to order.

Welcome: Randy welcomed all new and returning boosters, and gave a quick overview of the new booster website.

A.D. Report: Darren was not present.

Treasurer's Report: Van presented. See report. General Fund = \$32,852.37; GIFT Fund = \$14,941.38; Sr. All-Night Party Fund = \$4,432.45. George Peters Fund: \$1,310 (in the general fund) which will be used for the new gym water fountain.

Membership Report: Windy presented. 64 paid, 30 new, 34 returning, and 18 potential. Randy thanked all who helped during student registration in August.

Sports Program: Sharon presented. Ordered 600 fall programs. \$11,475 in ad sales. Will be distributed at gates and also at local businesses. Using Salem Blueprinting for printing.

Thank you: Randy presented a list of the accomplishments for the last two years, and thanked the boosters and board from the previous two years.

Officer Nominations: President (2-year term) Randy Forrette; Vice President (1-year term) Sharon Goodman; Secretary (2-year term) Jody Classen; Treasurer (1-year term) Van Schoenborn.

Board Nominations: (1-year term) Ann Lindemann, Erin Cramer; (2-year term) Amy Carey, Jennifer Jungwirth, Darren Classen. All positions were unanimously approved by a full vote of the boosters.

Lead Positions: Randy presented a handout on current lead positions needed, completed projects, projects in process and upcoming projects. We still need to fill lead positions for Marketing, Ad Sales, Alumni, Spring/Fall Cleanup Days, and Grant Writing.

Project review: Randy listed all completed, in process, and upcoming projects. We need help to paint the ceiling of the Eagles' Roost Team Room – No volunteers. And the booster shack roof leaks. Van obtained free roofing materials. We need a small group to install the roof soon – No volunteers.

Auction: Randy explained that this is still our single largest fundraiser. All boosters need to help. Please contact Randy to see what you can do. The auction is scheduled for February 10, 2018 at Cascade Hall at the State Fairgrounds.

SPPC Painting Project: Adam Anundi and Rob Diehl have agreed to paint an eagle head on the pavement in the parking lot. All boosters are welcome. There was a conflict with the date, so a new date will be scheduled. Contact Adam and Rob to help.

Mobile Concessions: Coach Harmik shared his thoughts and the process on having a mobile concessions for food. He discussed start up needs, staffing, financial opportunities (\$35,000 in one week). Ken Carey offered the Spud Bus as a temporary concessions should the Board choose to go forward with the mobile concessions.

Scholarships: John Burton spoke briefly on how the scholarship process works. Ann Lindemann volunteered to chair the scholarships for 2018.

Custom Corrugated Player Cutouts: Cori Perez asked if boosters would be willing to fund player cutouts for the senior football players. The boosters liked the idea for all senior fall sports. The board will discuss and decide on funding.
