

Color Guard Fee Disclosure—Summer and Fall 2023 Season

Marching band/color guard programs are expensive endeavors. Because the school district doesn't provide financial assistance for the DHS Marching Band program, students must cover costs for the program to function and be competitive. Gratefully, we do have amazing fundraising events, such as Davis Cup and Moonlight Serenade, that help offset a portion of the cost. Here's a breakdown of fees the 2023 program.

Summer Band Fees (for ALL Summer Color Guard participants):

- \$100** Summer Band Fee (Pays for instruction, staff, and supply costs)
- \$46** Summer Parade Uniform Fee (We are purchasing parade uniforms—skort/shorts and top—that will be used from year to year. Uniforms will be returned at the end of the season. We are using some color guard fundraiser money to offset this cost for this year, but students are still asked to pay a portion so we can replace/purchase additional uniforms in the future. There will be a year to year fee associated with the parade uniform.)
- \$20** "Here's Looking at You" Marching Show T-shirt (Actual cost still to be determined but won't exceed \$20.)

Total Cost for Summer Marching Color Guard Participation: \$166

Please note: Parade uniforms will only be handed out to students who have paid summer band and summer uniform fees. Summer season payments are due June 22.

Fall Season Fees for ALL Color Guard participants:

- \$214** Fall Marching Fee—contributes 75% of cost of show music purchase, drill writing, design, props, and production equipment. (Band fundraisers like Davis Cup and Moonlight Serenade cover the remaining cost.)
- \$50** District Transportation Fee—helps pay for busing to and from competitions.
- \$130** Staff Compensation—contributes to cost of regular season instruction, staff pay)
- \$150** Marching Band Camp—pays for meals, activities, and band camp week instruction)
- \$225** Color Guard Fall Season Costumes (purchases costume for show)
- \$15** Color Guard Equipment Fee (used to replace worn and damaged equipment)
- \$5** Davis District Drug Test Fee

Total Cost for Fall Season Participation: \$789

Only for Marching Band/Color Guard student leaders:

- \$45** One-day Leadership Retreat—contributes toward food and transportation for one-day, off-site leadership training.

Total Possible Cost for Summer and Fall Color Guard participation (combined): \$955-1000

Additional Cost (Pending Approval) State Championship St. George Trip

- \$265-\$365?** We don't have a good estimate for you this year—numbers could change. A new district policy requires that each student has their own bed (while still requiring at least three students per room). We are working to find hotels that can accommodate this request at a reasonable price. Parents will be told costs up front and can complete a PTA survey about the trip before it is approved.
