Make sure to report all property damages to both 2-1-1 *and* FEMA.

- Apply immediately – you only have 30 days from July 14.
- If you are denied FEMA disaster funds, go through the appeals process. There is often something you can fix in your application and eventually get funding.

### **Water**

*Well-water testing kits:* Vermont Department of Health has these. You should test your private well or spring if you were in an area that flooded or if there was pooling around your wellhead. Get kits at:

- Johnson Elementary (Tuesday and Wednesday)
- Hazen Union (Thursday, Friday, Saturday)
- Department of Health Office, 63 Professional Drive, Morrisville

*Water library:* United Community Church of Morrisville and Morrisville Water and Light are still handing out water to those affected by the boil order.



### **What is WCC and what is this email?**
