

Parents and Students:

We are looking forward to the upcoming school year and all of the great students attending Chisholm Middle School.

Student cell phones, air pods, or Bluetooth headphones will only be allowed before or after school and during their lunch time. During instructional time all cell phones must be turned off and stored in the classroom cell phone holder or in the students bookbag. During class students may NOT use their cell phones for calculators, checking time, music reading, checking grades or any other reasons. If there is a medical reason to use a cell phone, that may be allowed per a 504 or health plan, with prior approval. Phones will not be allowed during P.E. or while in restrooms.

We understand that it is difficult to feel out of touch, but parents can call the office to relay messages to students or reach students through their school issued email. Some of the difficulties we face with hundreds of cell phones being used by students include:

- Students taking pictures in the classroom of other students without prior permission and posting on social media.
- Students continuously taking out their phones during class and not staying on task.
- Students taking pictures/videos and posting on social media during the school day.
- Students watching movies/listening to music while in class.
- Students participating in group texts/chats during the day to make fun of other students or staff members.

Chisholm Middle School Before/After School Procedures



Before School Procedures:

Athletic Entrance Opens at 7:35am

Front Entrance Opens at 7:35am

- The front door entrance and athletic entrance doors will be open at 7:35 am each morning
- Students may come into the building through either the front entrance or athletic entrance
- Students who are eating breakfast will go directly to the cafeteria. All other students will go directly to the gym area
- 7th grade students will go to the Old Gym (Railer East) and wait until the dismissal bell rings
- 8th grade students will go to the New Gym (Railer West)
- Students are not allowed to be in the hallways prior to the dismissal bell, which rings at 7:59am
- Students are dismissed by team after the 7:59 am bell rings to go to their first hour class
- **7:59 -** 7 Gold Dismissed from Gym
- 8:00 7 Black Dismissed from Gym
- 8:01 8 Black Dismissed from Gym
- 8:02 8 Gold Dismissed from Gym
- 8:05 CLASS STARTS FOR ALL STUDENTS


After School Procedures:

- Students who walk home or get a ride should leave school grounds immediately after school. Students should not "hang out" on school grounds
- Students who ride the bus should wait in designated area in front of the school until buses arrive/leave
- Student athletes should proceed directly to their practice
- Students participating in Railer Power Hour or Connections should go directly to the cafeteria to check in

Railer Power Hour and Connections After School Programs

What is Railer Power Hour (RPH) and Connections?

These are Chisholm after school programs that take place from 3:20 - 5:00 pm Monday through Thursday each week. Railer Power Hour also operates before school from 7:15 - 7:45 am.

Railer Power Hour (RPH) is a before and after school homework help program.

Connections is an after school activities program. There will be various activities that students can participate in each week.

When will RPH and Connections begin?

We will start these after school programs the week after the Labor Day holiday.

Will transportation be available after RPH and Connections is over?

Yes, transportation is provided if needed for students at the end of RPH and Connections each day. Transportation is available to the nearest neighborhood school for students at the end of RPH/Connections.

- Before and After school homework help program
- Before school 7:15-7:45 am, After school 3:20 5:00 pm
- Takes place in the CMS cafeteria
- Provides a quiet place for students to work on homework
- CMS Staff available to help students with class work
- Mrs. Penner is the head teacher for Railer Power Hour.

- After school activities program
- Provides different activities for students to participate in throughout the year
- Activities that have been done previously include cooking club, arts and crafts, sketch club, anime club, ESports, and Magic the Gathering games

School Resources Information

You may hear about Canvas, Infinite Campus, Clever, and Xello, when talking about your student's education. Here is a guide to explain the difference between these resources.

Infinite Campus

Infinite Campus (grades, attendance, fees, food service)

- Infinite Campus is a Student Information System (SIS)
- Infinite Campus is the resource that the district uses to track student attendance, demographic information, behavior reports, and grades
- Grades are updated once per week (by Tuesday evening) in Infinite Campus
- This is the main platform used for updating student grades, attendance, and fee payments



Canvas (class assignments and lesson plans)

- Canvas is a Learning Management System (LMS)
- Canvas is a place to organize class content and share it with students.
- Content will be added by teachers for students to access. This can include assignments, what to work on each week, due dates, and other information.
- This is the main platform to find detailed information about each class your student is taking.




Clever (student login resource)

- Clever is a single sign in system for all of the various student resources
- Students login to Clever and it keeps them signed into other platforms, such Canvas, Naviance, and other programs.



Xello (Individual Plan of Study and Career Preparation)

- Xello is the platform used for our Individual Plan of Study for each student
- Xello has a wide variety of resources in it about career possibilities, college information, scholarships, applications, and more.
- Students take a variety of surveys in Xello to learn about their Learning Style and Career interests.
- Students will continue to use Xello at Newton High School. Students can create a digital resume and portfolio.


Directions for Setting Up Parent Observer Access in Canvas

1. The parent will first need to ask their child to sign on to Canvas and generate a pairing code. See instructions for the student below:


Open Settings

Copy the six-digit alphanumeric pairing code [1]. You will need to share the code with the observer who will link to your account. The pairing code will expire after seven days or its first use.




