HIB Other District Efforts, 2022-2023



- Taskforce of Anti-bullying Coordinator, Anti-bullying Specialists and administrators reviewed updated our HIB policy to more closely align with the law and our needs
- All administrators and counselors attended a 3 hour in person HIB training by Legal One in March of 2023
- Professional Learning Community of the ABC and ABS met bi-weekly to ensure consistent application of the HIB law across buildings.
- Internal processes were reviewed and streamlined regarding parent notification.
- Parent letters were edited to add more empathy.
- Bi-monthly HIB Board Report was updated to be more transparent and concise.
- BTAM training sessions attended by most counselors and crisis team members.
- HIB Self-assessment in the Fall was done in a collaborative and transparent effort, with all ABS together asking questions, interpreting the indicators, and deciding on scores.
