Purpose

In order to promote and recognize excellence demonstrated by district students, the Board shall recognize individual students by granting awards for outstanding achievement.

Guidelines

Academic

Students who have attained top honors, recognition, or championship status in any school-related activity or competition (local, regional, state, and/or national) will be presented for recognition and honored at a school Board meeting and presented with a certificate.

Students who qualify for state and/or national competitions, regardless of placement status, will be honored by the Board and presented with a certificate.

A plaque may be awarded to students earning the highest honors, if deemed appropriate by the administration.

Top Scholars

The administration is authorized to establish criteria for and recognize students through Top Scholars.

Athletic

Any athletic team that wins first place in its section and athletic teams and team members who win a WPIAL championship and/or qualify for PIAA competition, will be honored by the Board and given a certificate.

A plaque may be awarded to students earning the highest honors, if deemed appropriate by the administration.

Delegation of Responsibility

Any unusual event or circumstances worthy of recognition and not implicit in this policy shall be left to the discretion of the administrative staff.
