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# Daily Schedule

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- Lunch
- School Work Support
- Indoor Play
- Outdoor Play



# Requirements

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- License exempt due to oversight by Department of Education for school age children
- May only take students from school site where program is held
- Any new construction must meet modern Title 5 size requirements, including 1,350 sq ft (from 960 sq ft), classroom supervision of play yard, location near drop-off/bus loading areas, and self-contained restrooms within the classroom



# Requirements for Staffing Ratio

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Must maintain staffing ratio requirements from Community Care Licensing Division

- 1 qualified staff to 12 children
- 1 qualified staff and 1 aide to 15 children
- 1 qualified staff and 1 fully qualified aide to 18 children

*\*Qualified staff/aide = 6 ECE units*



# Fee Schedule Examples:

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- [SVUSD](#): \$600/month for 32.5 hrs/week or \$400/month for 19 hrs/week
- [FVSD](#): \$420/month for 21 hrs/week
- [MBUSD](#): \$670/month for 25 hrs/week
- [Coronado](#): \$800/month for 31 hrs/week or \$480/month for 15 hrs/week



# TK Extended Day Program Information

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## Early Start TK

Times: 11:45-3:30 (approx 19 hours/week)

Expected interest: 5-6 students per school

Fee: \$525/month

## Late Start TK

Times: 2:10-3:30 (approx 7.75 hours/week)

Expected interest: 4-5 students per school

Fee: \$200/month

*\*EDP will be available when school is out early on Wednesdays and early dismissal days*



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
