DRESS CODE

Rowland Hall's dress code and uniform policies are intended to reinforce an environment that maximizes respect among faculty, staff, and students and fosters an atmosphere of learning. Each division has formulated its dress code/uniform policy based on the developmental stages of its students.

3PREK AND 4PREK

Children in 3PreK and 4PreK are not required to wear the Rowland Hall uniform. They are encouraged to wear clothes that easily promote self-dressing skills, are appropriate for play and messy activities, are not distracting for themselves or their peers, and are not hazardous on the playground. The school suggests that children wear:

- Clothing that is casual, comfortable, and washable
- Clothing that is easy to manage at toilet time
- Shoes that enclose the entire foot and have rubber soles (no sandals, jellies, or other open shoes)
- Hats, boots, snowsuits, and gloves when appropriate for outside wear
- A sunhat is required for outdoor times
- A tote bag for carrying home schoolwork and projects is helpful

One complete change of clothing is expected to be kept in the classroom, labeled with the child's name and children attending Extended need a tote bag or backpack to transfer belongings successfully.

KINDERGARTEN

As children mature, they are ready for the school's increased expectations which include adhering to a uniform policy in Kindergarten.

UNIFORM (Monday–Thursday)

SHIRTS

- Long or short-sleeved collared shirts in solid white, navy blue or hunter green.

SWEATERS/SWEATSHIRTS/VESTS

- Solid navy blue or hunter green sweaters, including pullovers, cardigans and vests, always with a solid-colored shirt underneath
- RH logo sweatshirts or fleece vests purchased from Dennis Uniform, Land's End, and the school store

BOTTOMS

- Solid, navy blue or Blackwatch plaid pants, capris, shorts, skirts, skorts
- Solid navy leggings may be worn as pants, must be opaque when bending, climbing, etc.
- We recommend solid-colored shorts, leggings or tights under skirts, for carefree monkey bars and tree climbing.

SOCKS & SHOES

- All shoes should enclose the entire foot and have rubber soles. Shoes with laces must have the laces in and tied.
- Socks should be worn with all shoes.

FREE DRESS FRIDAY

Every Friday, students may wear non-uniform clothes within dress code. **The first and last day of school and picture day are Free Dress days.**

PHYSICAL EDUCATION ATTIRE

Students need to be able to move freely and we recommend they wear clothes allowing a full range of motion. Students must wear athletic shoes for PE with sufficient support, tied or secured with Velcro.

SUNHATS

Students are required to wear sunhats when outdoors.

JEWELRY AND COSMETICS

Please avoid sending your child to school with these items.

LABEL EVERYTHING

Many children have the exact same clothing. Please label everything.
