Please consider buying all necessities needed for St. Croix online or bring them with you in person. **Upon new student arrival, we will be making a few trips to Target for school supplies and Dicks Sporting Goods for fall athletic gear.** These events are scheduled on the **Dormitory Portal - Calendar**. We also make weekly trips during the school year to local stores for necessities.

Many students will have items shipped to them including athletic gear, school supplies (calculators), and toiletries when they arrive on campus - or bring them with you as needed. **Amazon** is a great option for all of these items. Please communicate with your dormitory ambassador ahead of arrival for additional information regarding what to bring.

LIST OF IMPORTANT AND SUGGESTED ITEMS FOR RESIDENCE LIVING

- School and Dormitory Dress Code**
- Towels: hand, face & bath
- Alarm clock
- Toiletries -you will be able to shop at local stores each week, so you do not need to bring a full year of supplies.
- Desk items / school supplies**
- Desk lamp: non-halogen bulbs
- Laundry supplies-the laundry facilities at St. Croix are card operated. The student will purchase his or her laundry card upon arrival (\$5.00) and can load cash onto their laundry cards near the laundry rooms
- Laundry bag (please no baskets)
- Clothes hangers
- Cell phone or video chat on device for calling home.
- Power strip cord with a surge protector (all electronics must be plugged in with this type of cord)
- Form of payment for items students buy around St. Croix
- Command hooks - Only 3M hooks are allowed in the dormitory for hanging items in rooms.
- Prescription for eyeglasses/contacts
- Sports gear**



PROVIDED BY St. Croix:

- Linens (fitted sheet, flat sheet, and 1 pillowcase) Students also receive a pillow and one blanket. (Students may wish to purchase additional blankets.) Mattresses are regular twin in length.
- Furnished room: bed, linens, mattress, desk
- Mini-fridge (1 per room)
- Free wireless internet and access to black and white printer
- Pay card washing machines & dryers (student responsible for payment and laundry soap)
- Coin-operated snack vending machine
- Student lounges with television.

ITEMS TO NOT BRING:

- Large furniture
- Pets of any kind, including fish.
- Cooking items used for frying
- Microwaves
- Mini-fridges
- Over the counter medications (View [Medical Care at St. Croix](#) for our Medication Policy.)
